The Hidden Reasons for the Invasion and Occupation of Iraq by U.S. Military

In the U.S., we have corporate media gatekeepers, media monopolies, an astonishing loss of political ideas and a poorly informed citizenry, so it is no surprise the few people know the real reasons for the War on Iraq and Afghanistan, and the Sept. 11, 2001 World Trade Center and Pentagon airplane crashes that served to terrorize Americans into going to war.

REVIEW: Just before "God" told GW Bush to invade Afghanistan and Iraq, Saddam Hussain's press release announced that he would no longer sell Iraqi oil for US "Fiat" money, only gold backed currency like the Euro! Furthermore in a 1987 book entitled Secret Wars of the CIA 81-87 and the newsmedia showed that the team of Reagan, Bush, Cheney, Wolfowitz, Rumsfeld and Pearl wanted to do a preemptive strike against Iraq back in the eighties! In 1996 these same fellows sent a letter, signed by the same cartel, asking President Clinton to prosecute a pre-emptive strike against Iraq.

The entire misadventures of the Bush junta in Afghanistan and Iraq can best be understood as US dollar imperialism. An imperialistic regime extends its power and dominion over other nations through military, economic, and cultural means. This involves the military acquisition of territory, gaining control over the political and economic life of subject groups, and imposing its money system on conquered nations.

The international cabal was not responding to the trumped-up threats by Bush reporting Saddam's non-existent WMD program and certainly was not fighting International terrorism. The USA's invasion of Iraq involved much more than most people are aware of. Among the more obvious purposes were: the neo-colonial theft of Iraqi oil; the funnelling of oil and no-bid contracts into Haliburton; the installation of multiple U.S. military bases in the region; the installation of a puppet government in control of Iraq to comply with demands by USA.

Some of the hidden reasons the demonic cabal invaded and occupied Iraq are: to reconfigure the Middle East geopolitically; to gain strategic control over Iraq's--and the surrounding territory's--hydrocarbon reserves to establish a cabal-based energy market to replace OPEC to maintain the U.S. dollar as the monopoly currency for the critical international oil market.

Saddam Hussein's cardinal sin had been to tie Iraq's oil sales to the Euro. Saddam announced in September 2000 that Iraq was no longer going to accept dollars for oil being sold under the UN's Oil-for-Food program, and the switch to the Euro as Iraq's oil export currency. This was one of several dangerous steps towards establishing the Euro as an alternative oil transaction currency--the "PetroEuro"--that nations--including those within OPEC--had begun to contemplate seriously. The international cabal felt it had to show the world--through pre-emptive invasion of a sovereign nation without provocation or reason--that it would not tolerate any attempt to displace the U.S. dollar as the sole oil transaction currency. A Financial Times article dated June 5, 2003, confirmed that Iraqi oil sales had returned to the international markets and were once again denominated in U.S. dollars--not Euros.

The Bush junta implemented this currency transition despite the adverse impact it had on profits from Iraq's export oil sales. In mid-2003 the Euro was valued approximately 13% higher than the dollar. The conversion from the Euro to the dollar negatively impacted the ability of future oil proceeds to rebuild Iraq's infrastructure. This sabotaging of Iraqi oil revenues was never mentioned in the five U.S. major media conglomerates who control 90% of information flow in the U.S. Surprise, surprise.

A powerful new coalition is forming to struggle against the cabal's dollar imperialism. This coalition includes nations that possess economic and military might. Venezuelan leader Hugo Chavez has established barter deals for trading its oil with twelve Latin American countries as well as Cuba. The cabal's hit man Rumsfeld is already threatening this coalition with U.S. military action.

These new coalition partners--as much concerned with geostrategic issues as purely economic issues--are also being joined by nations such as Japan, Pakistan, North Korea, and the OPEC and European Union countries in combating dollar imperialism. The coalition and its supporting nations all have good reason to be fed up with the cabal's imperialistic offensives. Many of them had legitimate energy and manufacturing contracts with Iraq totaling trillions of dollars. The cabal brazenly nullified all those contracts when it invaded Iraq and took control of the country. The ongoing assaults on their economies by the cabal's dollar imperialism leaves all of them working toward a way to get out from under the American puppet junta's thumb. They are forming agreements and joint ventures among themselves to achieve their goal of independence from the cabal.

The OPEC countries know that the cabal has set up its Caspian Sea pipelines in an effort to undercut it, and the European Union countries have experienced continual threats and assaults on their economies from the cabal. The cabal Treasury Secretary, for example, threatens to weaken the dollar whenever the European Union nations are perceived to be getting out of line with cabal policy. A weaker dollar is a direct attack on the other economies of the world.

Ed Case to Challenge Akaka

Hawaii Congressman Ed Case announced last week that he will challenge fellow Democrat Daniel Akaka for his US Senate seat. Case said neither of Hawaii's long-term senators will be able to serve indefinitely. He said at a news conference in Honolulu that the transition requires that voters phase in the next generation to provide continuity.

The 81-year-old Akaka already has indicated he will run for re-election for a fourth term this year, and no Republican challenger has emerged.

If both men stay in the race, they will face off in the state primary election on September 23rd.

The 53-year-old Case was elected to Congress in a special election in 2002 to fill the seat vacated with the death of Congresswoman Patsy Mink. He was later elected to serve a full term when the late congresswoman was re-elected.

Akaka had served 14 years in the House before he was appointed to replace Senator Spark Matsunaga when he died of cancer in 1990.

Case could be effective in facilitating the Home Pumehana residents complaints against Manage Jersula Manaba and Administration because of the federal HUD \$\$.

Abercrombie: Equality for Filipino Vets?

World War II Filipino veterans deserve equal treatment with their American counterparts. That's why I'm sponsoring legislation to restore full VA benefits to this dwindling group of soldiers who served the cause of freedom.

Last month, I participated in a Filipino Veterans Forum in Washington DC. Other members of Congress and I heard testimony from Filipino veterans and others working for full equality. The event renewed our determination to push for full recognition of their contributions during some of the darkest days of World War II. We were reminded of how these brave soldiers fought shoulder to shoulder with their American comrades in arms, suffered the same hardships, and sacrificed in the same cause. When America needed their help, they answered the call.

During World War II the United States acknowledged its responsibility for full benefits for Filipino veterans, but their equal status was rescinded by the Rescission Act of 1946. Simple justice demands that we recognize their equal contributions with equal veterans' benefits. We have made important gains in recent years, but we still have a long way to go before achieving full equity.

I am a long-time champion for Filipino veterans and have sponsored many bills to achieve that goal. The most recent bill is the bipartisan Filipino Veterans Equity Act of 2006 (also known as H.R. 4574). This legislation would extend to Filipino veterans full equality with their U.S. counterparts in respect to the entire range of VA benefits.

A 2001 Department of Veterans Affairs Study estimated the total number of Filipino veterans at about 60,000, with approximately 14,000 living in the United States. Most of the veterans are in their late seventies or eighties, and the study estimates that the total Filipino veteran population will number about 20,000 in 2010.

In 2003, I joined other advocates to secure the passage of two bills to broaden their eligibility for health care and higher benefit payments:

1) The Veterans Benefits Act of 2003 increased VA benefit payments to U.S.-resident Filipino veterans and their survivors to the same levels as those paid to U.S. veterans and survivors. It also made New Philippine Scouts eligible for burial in U.S. national cemeteries. Previously, benefit payments for Filipino veterans and their survivors were only half the amounts paid to U.S. veterans and survivors.

2) The Veterans Health Care Authorities Extension and Improvement Act of 2003 removed significant restrictions on VA health care eligibility by authorizing VA medical services for U.S.-resident veterans of the Commonwealth Army of the Philippines and New Philippine Scouts on the same basis as veterans of the U.S. Armed Forces. Under previous law, both groups of veterans were eligible for VA medical services only if they were disabled and received VA payments. In addition, New Philippine Scouts could receive care only for service-connected disabilities. Previous law did not place these same restrictions on U.S. Armed Forces veterans.

These laws are important steps in the right direction, but I will not be satisfied until Filipino veterans are treated equally in every respect. You can be sure that I will continue the effort. Sincerely, Neil Abercrombie

Mrs. Grambusch Retires from DOE



An integral part of Molokai schools for forty years, Mrs. Wilma Likolehua Kamakana Grambusch officially retired on December 31, 2005. After suffering a stroke on Easter Sunday, 2005, "Auntie Liko" to family and friends, has been in and out of hospitals and rehab centers. Family and friends, children and teachers sent prayers and cards of get well wishes.

Mrs. Grambusch is a product of Hawaii public and private schools and has always been an advocate for better education. She went to Kualapuu School from Kindergarten through 5th grade, when "English Standard" schools taught the basics of reading, writing and arithmetic with emphasis on proper English speech and writing. For the sixth grade, she attended Kaunakakai School, where her mother, Edith Kamakana was a teacher. Her father, William Kamakana was a livestock farmer and helped to further her education at St. Andrews Priory in Honolulu for the 7th and 8th grades. As student, Wilma Kamakana, she graduated from Punahou school, class of 1953. She went away to California for college and graduated from Whittier College with a Education and Speech Pathology degrees.

In 1959, the year Hawaii gained statehood, Wilma Kamakana married Jackie Lee Grambusch and the couple moved back to Molokai.. The couple raised four children, Jackie, Jr.; William, Ellen Pohai, and Andrew Kiniakua. Her husband, passed away a few years ago. Currently, her son William, daughter-in-law Nanette, and three of her nine grandchildren are close by her at home.

Mrs. Grambusch has been a tireless advocate for special education needs for Molokai's children and for land and water rights. There was a time when Mrs. Grambusch traveled regularly to Lanai to do hearing screening for school children there. Using the "Dolch" word list, computers and the tools speech therapists have to help children with special needs. As an itinerant speech therapist traveling from school to school, she worked with hundreds of children through the years and always urged "her children" to do their best.

For health reasons, Mrs. Grambusch has retired from the DOE. Her aloha thoughts are: "I wish the DOE (Department of Education) lots of luck. And for the families, pay attention to your children's education, because if you don't who will?"

Auntie Liko continues on the road to improving health. Although she no longer drives her little car, she hasn't forgotten the children she has taught, so if you see her in Kaunakakai cruising in her wheelchair, say "hello" and give her a hug.

Government is the Problem, Not the Solution


In all times and in all places there has been too much government.

We now know what prosperity is: it is the gradual extension of the division of labour through the free exchange of goods and ideas, and the consequent introduction of efficiencies by the invention of new technologies. This is the process that has given us health, wealth and wisdom on a scale unimagined by our ancestors. It not only raises material standards of living, it also fuels social integration, fairness and charity. It has never failed yet. No society has grown poorer or more unequal through trade, exchange and invention. In every case, weak or decentralised government, but strong free trade led to surges in prosperity for all, whereas strong, central government like Hawaii's Police State by Lingle, led to parasitic, tax-fed officialdom, a stifling of innovation, relative economic decline and usually war.

Yes, governor Linda Lingle has bodyguards, even when she was mayor of Maui county. Sometimes, they say we need it to protect exchange from corruption, to set the standards and police the rules, in which case they have a point, though often they exaggerate it. Self-policing standards and rules were developed by free-trading merchants in medieval Europe long before they were taken over and codified as laws (and often corrupted) by monarchs and governments.

Sometimes, they say we need it to protect the weak, the victims of technological change or trade flows. But throughout history such intervention, though well meant, has usually proved to be protection for elite government powers, and/or misguided because its progenitors refuse to believe or find out about David Ricardo's Law of Comparative Advantage: even if China is better at making everything than France, there will still be a million things China will buy from France rather than make itself. Why? Because rather than invent, say, luxury goods or insurance services itself, China will find it pays to make more T shirts and use the proceeds to import goods and insurance.

Government is a very dangerous. It is used to fight wars, impose ideologies and enrich rulers. Our leaders today enrich their clients: they preside over vast an insatiable parasitic bureaucracies that grow by Parkinson's Law and live off true wealth creators such as traders and inventors.

Sure, it is possible to have too little government. Only, that has not been the world's problem for millennia. After the century of Mao, Hitler and Stalin, can anybody really say that the risk of too little government under Bush or Lingle is greater than the risk of too much? The dangerous idea we Americans all need to learn is that the more we limit the government, the better off we will all be.

Judges are impeachable. Furthermore, judges may be removed immediately for violating oaths of office, involvement in conspiracies, extortion, and failing to uphold their duty to the common law. Judges can also be arrested, they are not exempt from this nor are any other officials, including the President of the United States.

Do the people have the power to do this? Yes, the people have the power to do everything to defend our country against all enemies foreign or domestic politician, and government has no power to say otherwise. Fascist bureaucrats might send out its armed marauders, but a huge group of The People (Militia) armed with guns as guaranteed their Right to keep and bear arms by the 2nd Amendment is likely to stop them unless the governments decide that it is time to begin mass killings of all people who believe in the rights of Man. **Wake up ! Enforce the Bill of Rights !**

"A well regulated militia, being necessary to the security of a free state, the right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed." Exercise the 2nd Amendment.
