Maui County Council Resolutions honoring the four kupuna and their ancestors, pioneers to Hawaii, were presented by Councilman Danny Mateo. Also honored by a Mayoral Commendation was Harry Chung, the first Chinese market established in Kaunakakai. His granddaughter, Rina Chung received the proclamation from Larry Helm, emcee for the event.




Maunaloa School, is threatened with closure. Public meetings have been held in the community to address the effects. Petitions are also being circulated. Both issues have island-wide effects.



US Military Accused of Occupation in Haiti as 10,000 Troops Position There

While Obama's Secretary of State Hillary Clinton posed for photos and interviews at the Port Auy Prince air port, American military air traffic controllers turn away medical aid flights from France and China.

France accused the US of "occupying" Haiti on Monday as thousands of American troops flooded into the country to take charge of aid efforts and security. US troops have taken control of Haiti's ruined presidential palace.

The French minister in charge of humanitarian relief called on the UN to "clarify" the American role amid claims the military build up was hampering aid efforts. Alain Joyandet admitted he had been involved in a scuffle with a US commander in the airport's control tower over the flight plan for a French evacuation flight. "This is about helping Haiti, not about occupying Haiti," Mr Joyandet said.

Geneva-based charity Medecins Sans Frontieres backed his calls saying hundreds of lives were being put at risk as planes carrying vital medical supplies were being turned away by American air traffic controllers.

But US commanders insisted their forces' focus was on humanitarian work and last night agreed to prioritise aid arrivals to the airport over military flights, after the intervention of the UN.

The diplomatic row came amid heightened frustrations that hundreds of tons of aid was still not getting through. Charities reported violence was also worsening as desperate Haitians took matters into their own hands.

The death toll is now estimated at up to 200,000 lives. Around three million Haitians – a third of the country's population – have been affected by Tuesday's earthquake and two million require food assistance.

While food and water was gradually arriving at the makeshift camps which have sprung up around the city, riots have broken out in other areas where supplies have still not materialised.

Haiti was occupied by the US between 1915 and 1935, and Clinton's efforts to prevent Haiti's President Aristide from returning to his country continue to run hostile feelings among many Haitians, even though American military commanders have repeatedly stressed that they are not entering the country as an occupying force. A paratrooper sergeant said they were authorised to use "deadly force" if they see anyone's life in danger but only as a "last resort".

The main responsibility for security rests with the UN, which is to add a further 3,000 troops to its force of 9,000. But UN "peacekeeping" forces currently stationed in Haiti have been accused of rape, child abuse, and murder.

Naomi Klein warns that Disaster Capitalism will want to take advantage of the tragedy for profit. Having the US military on the ground and in control of the country prepares the way for that to occur. She quotes from a Heritage Foundation document posted on the web and then removed and revised: "In addition to providing immediate humanitarian assistance, the U.S. response to the tragic earthquake in Haiti earthquake offers opportunities to re-shape Haiti's long-dysfunctional government and economy as well as to improve the public image of the United States in the region."

The final piece of this picture is of course that the Bill Clinton et al was responsible for kidnapping and removing Haiti's democratically elected president. Under Aristide the illiteracy rate was cut in half, from about 90% to about 45%. Literate, educated people are less likely to be willing to work in the sweatshops that Clinton encouraged to make use of displaced farm labor that flocked to the cities. What happened to the farms? Haitian agriculture was destroyed by US forcing the country to import cheap American rice.

According to the Times of London, US-led troops dragged innocent children from their beds and shot them during a nighttime raid. 
The goal of the founders of America was to restrict government within severe limits and to protect the rights of sovereign individuals. Government has NO rights!

In addition to the prize money, winners will receive assistance in getting their papers published and two-year subscriptions to The Independent Review. Medical Marijuana Passed in New Jersey

In a pair of votes by the New Jersey legislature on the last day of the session New Jersey lawmakers gave final approval to a medical marijuana bill, which Gov. Jon Corzine (D) has said he will sign, and will make that the 14th state to join Hawaii to approve the medical use of marijuana, although it is still illegal according to federal DEA.



The bill is one of the most restrictive yet, but it's one more state on the bandwagon. "It does not make sense for many of New Jersey's residents to suffer when there is a viable way to ease their pain," said Assemblyman Reed Gusciora, one of the sponsors of the bill. "Medical marijuana can alleviate a lot of suffering, and there is no evidence that legalizing it for medical use increases overall drug use."


Qualifying medical conditions include severe or chronic pain, severe nausea or vomiting or cachexia brought on by HIV/AIDS or cancer/treatments, muscular dystrophy, inflammatory bowel diseases, chronic pain, and terminal illnesses where the patient has less than a year to live. "This will be the strictest medical marijuana law in the nation," Gusciora said at a press conference Monday.

"We have a good bill that will be very strict and will not decriminalize marijuana, but will allow doctors to prescribe the best treatment for their patients."

The bill was supported by organizations including the New Jersey State Nurses Association, the New Jersey Academy of Family Physicians, the New Jersey Hospice and Palliative Care Organization, the New Jersey League for Nursing, the American Civil Liberties Union of New Jersey, the New Jersey chapters of the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, and the Coalition for Medical Marijuana-New Jersey.



