Bothered by Fruit Flies?

Suppression Study Aims to Eradicate the Pests


Melon Fly, Oriental Fruit Fly, Mediterranean Fruit Fly and Solanaceous Fruit Fly -- four economically important fruit flies affect the quality and marketability of produce in Hawaii. According to Alton Arakaki, University of Hawaii Extension Agent on Molokai, "The population of fruit flies on Molokai continues to thrive unchallenged, migrating from seasonal crops we grow to fruiting plants in the wild."

For several years, a fruit fly study team from the USDA and College of Tropical Agriculture & Human Resources have been conducting fruit fly management studies on Maui, Oahu and Hawaii. They have developed techniques and tools to reduce fruit fly infestations. Last fall the HAW-FLYPM (Hawaii Area Wide Fruit Fly Integrated Pest Management Program) expanded to include Kaua'i and Moloka'i.

On November 19th the second Fruit Fly Management Workshop was held at Hikiola Cooperative. More than twenty farmers and home gardeners signed up to be cooperators and received fruit fly traps, lures and bait. Trenton Yasui, HAW-FLYPM explained the program, (1) Monitoring using provided traps and lures; (2) Sanitation techniques by composting, bagging, burying, grinding or use as animal feed; (3) and earth-friendly Protein Bait Spray preparation and use.

After viewing a concise visual presentation on the HAW-FLYPM goal to promote a sustainable suppression program using an "area-wide approach to managing fruit flies, fielding questions, providing answers, Trenton Yasui and his team invited participants to sign up. Cooperators received male fruit fly lures for either Oriental Fruit Fly (citrus, guava, mango, papaya) and or Melon Fly (melons, squash, cucumber, tomato, egg plant). Also attending this second workshop was Ronald Mau, CTAHR entomologist who gave valuable hints.

The monitoring, suppression and protein bait spray application is easy as 1,2,3. If you're interested in participating in the suppression of fruit flies, improving the health of your garden produce, attend the next session. Call Alton Arakaki (567-6934) to learn when the next workshop will be held here.

Essays Sought to Pay Tribute to Sakadas for the Centennial Celebration of Filipino Migration to Hawaii

The Filipino Association of University Women (FAUW) is calling for essays of sakadas, or farmers, who were recruited from the Philippines between 1906 and 1946 as the last group of contract laborers for Hawaii's sugar and pineapple industries. Through these stories, FAUW aims to meet its mission of raising awareness and fostering pride in Filipino culture and traditions in the Filipino American community.

The goals of this essay project are to perpetuate Hawaii's talk story tradition across generations, to cultivate critical thinking. Collective efforts are needed right away to write down and preserve the litany of dreams and realities of sakada life, in order to understand the significant role of sakadas in Hawaiian and American history.

Although many spry sakadas continue to thrive as living treasures on all islands, most are becoming frail or have passed on. Brief essays (no longer than one page in length) are therefore sought from sakadas, their descendants, and friends. Photos or mementos (e.g., bango numbers, labor contract, newspaper articles) are encouraged. A sample essay topic may be "Sakadas' influenced our community."

People are invited to turn in essays from now through next July. They may be included as part of other activities to observe the 100th anniversary of Filipinos in Hawai'i. All essays will be unveiled as a legacy in Dec. 2006 to mark sakada contributions to culminate centennial festivities. Details to come.

Bill of Rights Day Resolution Bill of Rights Day December 15

We, the Council of Maui County, State of Hawaii, do solemnly proclaim the following:

Whereas,

1. The First Ten Amendments to the Constitution of the United States of America, know collectively as the Bill of Rights, were ratified on December 15, 1791;

2. The Bill of Rights recognizes, affirms and protects fundamental human and civil rights for which persons of all races have struggled for thousands of years;

3. To preserve the rights and freedoms secured by the Bill of Rights, our Forefathers, and hundreds of thousands of men and women serving on the police agencies and Armed Forces of the United States, have sacrificed, suffered and died;

4. The rights and freedoms guaranteed by the Bill of Rights deserve perennial celebrations; the sacrifices made to protect the Bill of Rights deserve eternal remembrance;

5. In Maui County there has been no regular formal observance of a special day commemorating the ratification of the Bill of Rights. Several of the original States refused to ratify the Constitution without an express Bill of Rights;

6. To commemorate the Bill of Rights with a special day would honor the fundamental rights it enshrines and the sacrifices made to create and preserve these rights, and would proclaim these rights to the citizens of the Maui County, Hawaii, to this Nation, and to the World;

Be it Therefore Resolved,

A copy of the Bill of Rights be conspicuously posted at Maui County Building, all courtrooms, all police stations, and provided to all citizens upon request. That December 15th of every year be designated Bill of Rights Day in the Maui County, Hawaii,

That all government agencies be encouraged to observe the annual Bill of Rights Day in a manner that brings to mind the meaning and importance of each of the Ten Articles contained in that Bill, and

That the first annual commemoration of Bill of Rights day shall be on December 15, 2006.

This proclamation and resolution is made by a vote of the majority of the Council of the Maui County, on this day, 2005.

Call your Maui County Councilmembers and state Legislators to take action now and pass the Bill of Rights Day December 15 Resolution.

Don't show your SOCIAL SECURITY # ?

The ONLY time that it is "required" by law to show or provide your private Social Security number, is when you are dealing directly with the Social Security Administration (SSA) in regard to your private SSA records. The rest: buzzoff!

You do not have to give your number to anybody outside of the SSA and if someone demands that you use it or "tries" to compel you to use your number on some form, then show them a copy of this federal law and demand they fully comply:

US Code Title 42, Section 408

(a) In general Whoever -

(8) discloses, uses, or compels the disclosure of the social security number of any person in violation of the laws of the United States; shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction thereof shall be fined under title 18 or imprisoned for not more than five years, or both.

Constitution Proscribes Licenses

The Constitution essentially proscribes all license laws with: "No state shall pass any law impairing the obligations of contracts", [see Art. 1, Sec. 10 of the Constitution for the United States of America]

Do we uphold and enforce the U.S. Constitution or don't we?



What Happened on 9-11-01?





Crimes of Politicians Must Be Stopped by The People (You are The Militia)
