6th Annual Moloka'i Community Health Fair 2009

Off to a running start at 6a.m. scores of runners/walkers in the annual 10K run from Kakahaia Park to Mitchell Pauole Center, Keiki Contest and HealthyBaby Contest were headline events at this year's Na Pu'uwai Health Fair. Cancer, Asthma, Diabetes, Heart, Kidney, Behavioral Health, Kupuna Services, Tobacco and Drug Prevention programs were featured informational booths. One of the newest programs was the Hawaii Nutrition and Physical Activity Coalition, who will work with community organizations to improve physical activity and nutrition through systems and environmental changes.

Maui Memorial Hospital's Outreach again offered cholesterol and glucose testing, blood pressure and glucose monitoring was available from the Na Pu'uwai booth. Molokai Community Health Center staff in planning stages of a new home continue to provide a variety of medical, dental, behavioral health and early intervention services. The highlight of the morning was the annual Meadow Gold Healthy Baby Contest. MC Wayde Lee kept the program moving as lucky numbers were called out and the top prize -trip to Las Vegas was eventually announced for a lucky adult who completed their signature card.

Ohana Health Center Listed to Receive \$750,000 Federal Aid Funding

Senator Inouye announced that federal aid is coming to Molokai as part of a \$387 million spending package for Hawaii. The spending provides substantial resources for military personnel and facilities, health care services, education, crime prevention and youth activities.

While many of these initiatives will help Molokai indirectly, one item will give Molokai \$750,000 for the new Molokai Ohana Health Center.

The old Pau Hana Inn was bought by the Molokai Community Health Center in May from the New Hope Christian Fellowship. The Pau Hana Inn — once one of two hotels in Kaunakakai — was sold by Molokai Ranch to New Hope in 2002. The inn was built in 1970 and sits on nearly six acres of oceanfront land.

Buildings at the Old Pau Hana Inn are currently being renovated by the Molokai Health Center, so that at least part of the new health center could be opened by the summer of 2010.

ObamaHealthCare = Gun Control

Obama's Health Care Reform will Regulate Guns? Health care reform is a brilliant way to regulate guns without violating the Second Amendment. Here is a preview of the new health insurance application forms: Name, address, age, gender, height, weight, prior medical conditions, do you smoke, do you own guns, if so how many and what kind...?

Health care reform, which seems completely innocuous to gun rights at first blush, is a Trojan Horse. Of that, there can be no doubt. The only real question is whether our enemies will choose to use it as such. Given the string of court and legislative defeats the anti-gun groups have suffered, is there any doubt whether Obama will pass up an opportunity to regulate guns in this oblique manner?

A Washington Times editorial taking the CDC to task for circumventing congressional orders to abstain from gun control "research" because this "research" would be using tax dollars to advance a gun control agenda. Now, under Obama, the CDC is defying this ban by researching "health care costs" and how guns impact health insurance and health care services. If any reader is in doubt as to what the results of this "research" will be, you might as well stop reading now.

So, sometime in the near future, a tax-payer funded study will show that gunshot wounds take up a tremendous amount of public medical resources, because the victims are uninsured. The study, of course, will fail to mention that the majority of this goes to criminal/gang elements injured during illegal activities. Sure, the Crips, Bloods, Triad, Mongols and the Mexican Mafia have no employee benefit plans (no 401K, dental, paid vacation etc) but is that really a basis for national health insurance policy that includes gun control prohibitions?

Why should gun owners care that this CDC "research" will show such an impact on health care insurance costs? The reason is called Underwriting.

Insurance premiums are calculated, in part, based upon your risk group. If you smoke, your premiums are higher. Why? Cigarette smoking demonstrably increases your health care costs over the long term. Have diabetes? Ditto. High blood pressure and cholesterol? Get out your wallet. And, if a "study" showing that the presence of a gun greatly increases health care costs, gun owners are now considered a high risk group and their insurance costs go up. "Owning a gun is same as having cancer...we aren't violating your civil rights. You may still own whatever guns you wish, you just are going to pay higher at-risk rates."

This scenario is not far-fetched or fanciful, the mechanism is already in place and is capable of operating exactly as I have outlined. The only question is whether Obama/Pelosi will have the political will to use it in such a manner, and to what extent.

Don't forget the new taxes on guns and ammo to help provide insurance for those poor Crips, Bloods, Triad, Mongols and Mexican Mafia members who find themselves suffering from uninsured gunshot wounds incurred during a drug deal gone wrong. The anti-gun possibilities are limited only by the imagination.

So what do gun owners need to do? We need to be calling our "Congress Critters" and demand, at a minimum, two things:

First, any health care reform bill must be absolutely, affirmatively firearm neutral. The law must explicitly state that no insurer, public or private, may use ownership or use of guns as a basis for underwriting or benefit decisions.

Second, any health care reform bill needs to explicitly deny insurance benefit payments for care provided to anyone who is harmed during the commission of a violent felony, and allow hospitals/doctors to choose to refuse treatment to these same people if they feel they can ethically do so. They may ethically feel they have to treat these people, but you and I should not be subsidizing medical care to Johnny Crackhead when he finds himself shot during a robbery, nor should we be subsidizing someone's ethics. Criminals start bearing the consequence of their actions and allow natural selection to work its magic.

Wake up militia! Use it, or lose it! Got your gun, yet?

The goal of the founders of America was to restrict government within severe limits and to protect the rights of sovereign individuals. Government has NO rights!



Citizen Attempts Arrest of George W. Bush for War Crimes

March 17, 2009: Mohawk Indian named John Boncore aka Dacajeweah or "Splitting the Sky" broke through the police line and advanced alone to arrest George Bush in a Calgary restaurant. Former U.S. President, George W. Bush, was in Calgary with "cowboy" hat in hand attending as speaker a \$400 plate dinner fundraiser. The Mohawk American Citizen got 2 to 3 feet into the Center. He pushed his way through the police line with his hands over his head yelling, "I am not touching anyone". They surrounded and pounced on him. He was brutalized, arrested and beaten over and over again in the police van and jail cell. He was kept for 24 hours and released on \$500 bail. He sustained serious bodily injuries, including a partial concussion and a massive hernia.

Now he faces six months in jail for attempting to arrest Bush there; trial in court on March 8th 2010 in Calgary Alberta.

OBAMA'S THREAT to the States

The Constitution for the United States of America is the document for our individual sovereignty because it was designed to keep the government in fear of the people – instead of the other way around, as we are now.

But the Obama regime has been employing an old tactic lately – what some might call an imperial threat – to We The People, here in America.

The state of Oklahoma is now the target of a direct challenge from Obama appointee US Attorney General Eric Holder, who is using the Civil Rights Act of 1964 as justification to violate Oklahoma's sovereignty as affirmed by the Tenth Amendment to the US Constitution.

In a letter written to the State Attorney General in April, the Federal government used aggressive language, bringing up the possibility of withholding Federal funds appropriated for Oklahoma. The reason? A proposed amendment to the State Constitution, which requires voter approval, that would make English the official language of the State.

English the official language of the State.

"What it indicates is the Federal Government's contempt for the states, in this case Oklahoma, and for the idea of federal – as opposed to national – government. AG Holder believes that Oklahoma is an administrative subdivision of the USA, and that it is perfectly right for him to coerce Oklahomans to do his will.

Oklahoma is not alone as a state challenged by central authority in recent months. Recently, federal firearms licensees in Tennessee and Montana received a letter from another Federal agency, the ATF, who had also issued a decree wrought with hubris – claims by the Federal government of their legal supremacy across the land.

DESTROYING LOCAL GOVERNMENT

"Both of these letters, particularly this letter to the Attorney General of Oklahoma, are very officious," observed Rob Natelson, professor of law at the University of Montana. "It reminds one eerily of the kinds of communications that started to come out from the Emperor to the local cities of the Roman Empire, beginning the course of the ultimate destruction of local government."

Professor Natelson is a widely-recognized expert on the framing and adoption of the United States Constitution, and on several occasions, he has been the first to uncover key key background facts about the Constitution's meaning. I knew this before our conversation. What I didn't know, however, was that he's also been studying Roman Law and history for the past 50 years, and is responsible for several works in that field.

"During the 2nd century AD, the Roman Emperors began increasingly to interfere with local government and they did this with...letters...letters that look something like this," continued Natelson, indicating the letter from Holder to

Oklahoma. "They started out as almost advisory and they got increasingly peremptory. By the end of the 2nd century, there was very little local government left. You had very few people, therefore, willing to participate in local elections; very little patriotic spirit towards one's own province or city. And this was the harbinger for the ultimate centralization of the Roman Empire."

He continued with a strong, decisive tone, "Almost everyone who's studied in that area agrees that the effect was to sap the life out of the empire, so that everything flowed to the center. All that counted was the Emperor and his bureaucrats...and his courtiers. I look at this and I see this letter which gets close to looking like an order from the central government down to a sovereign state legislature, and I say...WOW. This looks like something that Septimius Severus would have sent to the local officials."

In Columbus, Ohio last weekend, a rally in support of State Sovereignty drew around 7,000 people. Judge Andrew Napolitano addressed the rally and made similar comments indicating the nature of our current point in US history.

"In the long history of the world, very few generations have been granted the role of defending freedom in its maximum hour of danger. This is that moment and you are that generation"

IMPERIALISM AND DECLINE

Are these men 'crying wolf'

"Some people might think that's a far fetched analogy but I can't emphasize enough how important this development is seen by historians. When people think of the collapse of the Roman Empire they think of the fall of Rome in 476 AD. The conversion of Rome from a relatively free state – almost a Federation – into a totalitarian state, really picked up speed and accelerated during the 2nd century [AD], with this increasing intermeddling by the central authorities in local state government. That's what it reminded me of," recalled Natelson.

"[Obama's AG-Holder]... not violating any law by sending these letters, but there's a change in tone, there's a new and disturbing tone in them. At least the ATF letter was addressed to individuals. This one is addressed to a state legislature – really, it's a bit much. Besides the fact that there's the tone, there's the fact that they sent the letters at all. Most of the letters that were sent out by the emperor were called rescripts, and that's almost what the letter from Holder looks like. The one difference is that a rescript was usually a reply to a request for advice. In some ways this is worse than a rescript because this is unsolicited. A better way to compare it would be to an imperial decision or decree." Natelson added.

His Roman analogy is worth considering, for several reasons. Rome ended up a brutal dictatorship, but it began through a series of treaties between regions, and in some ways parallels present day America.

"When you draw comparisons between the U.S. and ancient Rome, you have to be very cautious, though Rome does have lessons to offer us and the history and results of the relentless centralization of the Empire is one of them," Natelson continued.

If there's a case to be made that the US is headed for the same sort of central plan that sucks the life out of a Republic, it would be difficult to imagine who in the United States could be encouraged by such a trend, outside of D.C.

"Certainly state legislators in Oklahoma and congressmen from Oklahoma should put the Federal Government on notice that they will support a substantial reduction in the budget for Holder's portion of the federal bureaucracy so long as he is trying to coerce them in this way." recommended Gutzman.

Worldwide trends in recent political elections do exhibit signs of a move away from central planner candidates, a trend the United States has been contrary to for nearly a decade, but perhaps the pendulum has reversed itself.

"As the economy grows increasingly complicated, increasingly interdependent and increasingly technological, centralized control (which never worked very well) works less and less, and people are less willing to stand for it. This reflects a visceral gut reaction people have against centralized control, because they know from their own life it makes no sense, though it always takes time for those megatrends to filter into the political class," Natelson continued.

People in the US are coming together by the thousands, demanding decentralization and nullification of Federal powers. Never before have the political elites had to contend with a non-partisan political force on such a massive scale. A storm seems to be brewing; a maelstrom of everyday Americans rallying around the document designed to keep the government in fear of the people – instead of the other way around.
