Kumu Humu O Moloka'i Celebrates Art of Quilting



he fiber art of quilting was celebrated at a one-day exhibit organized by friends of Aka'ula School. It starts from the *piko*-Hawaiian quilting -- designs and stitching. From Mary Kim's majestic Hawaiian Flag quilt to the queen-sized quilts by other Hawaiian Homesteaders and teachers Johanna Wong Leong and Helen Kalama, who taught a generation of quilters the art of quilting and traditional designs--ulu, naupaka, kalo, kukui-- were important to the people's lives.

Alu Like Kupuna *pohopoho* pieced quilts they created and the embroidered flowers of Hawaii and California are block-pieced by the California Polytechnic Women's Club with the guidance of Helen Kalama. Needleworking with thousands of stitches in a quilt, echo quilting and in the antique "crazy quilt" are well-preserved historical documents of an era without television and computers.

Molokai quilters also featured in this exhibit were Yvonne Friel, Joan Davis, Ginger Lavoie, Wilma Pratt, Ada DeCourcy, and Susie Bishaw. Traditional patterns, floral, fauna of land and sea, muslin, calico, and new color combinations tell a story of the exciting creative quilt patterns developed from skills taught over the decades by kupuna and makua needle crafters.

Visitors were treated to the rhythmical sound of kapa beaters as Mililani and Alapai Hanapi demonstrated their kapa making from home-grown olona fiber. The music of Kaleo Bishaw and his daughters were a fitting background to the quilts. A quilting class was held in the morning, while all day, the quilts, old and modern were enjoyed by a steady stream of needleworkers and visitors.

Jule Kamakana and Yvonne Friel organized the exhibit which included sale of kits of designs and kits Aka'ula students created with Paul Riel. Students sold quilt kits and a hearty bento as part of the fundraising event. Chinese Auction tickets were also available with quilt and needlework-related prizes. Thanks to the students, sponsors and volunteers who did a great job of assembling, sponsoring and hanging this inspiring show. Special thanks to the owners of these quilts who generously shared these special quilts -- both antique and modern.



Gun Rights Hawaii threatened

Ammunition Encoding Bill Looming in Hawaii!

Please Contact the Members of the House Public Safety Committee Today! House Bill 88, introduced by State Representative John Mizuno (D-30), would require all handgun ammunition manufactured or sold in Hawaii to be coded with a serialization number and entered into a statewide database at the time of sale. Encoded ammunition would be registered to the purchaser and would include the date of transaction, the purchaser's name, date of birth, driver's license number, and the serial number of the ammunition. The possession or sale of non-coded/serialized ammunition would be prohibited.

An identical measure died in committee last year, but this is a new legislature and we can't take anything for granted!

LETTER: Dear members of the House Public Safety Committee: On Thursday, January 29, you legislators of the Hawaii Public Safety Committee will hear legislation that could have dire consequences for our Right to Keep and Bear Arms in Hawaii.

I, along with thousands of law abiding Hawaii gun owners, respectfully urge you to protect the Second Amendment rights of Hawaii's law-abiding citizens by opposing HB88. It clearly infringes on our right to keep and bear arms. You have taken a solemn Oath of Office to uphold and defend and preserve the 2nd Amendment which is part of both the Constitution for the united States of America and the Hawaii State Constitution. HB 88 is tantmount to proposing TREASON, and the introducer Rep John Mizuno should be impeached out of office for violating his Oath. Remember, you folks are supposed to be PRO-TECTING our RIGHTS.

Crimes of Politicians Must Be Stopped by The People (You are The Militia)




Judges are impeachable. Furthermore, judges may be removed immediately for violating oaths of office, involvement in conspiracies, extortion, and failing to uphold their duty

OBAMA Promises already BROKEN! DEA Raids on MM Continue, and MPD Chief Thomas Phillips is a Fascist Stooge

During last year's historic campaign, Senator Obama promised that as president he would stop the DEA's raids on medical marijuana clinics in states that have laws protecting them. But already under the new administration such raids have happened twice. [Maui MPD Chief is again at Legislature lobbying against MM and telling Legislators that MPD is only after bad guys and MM is a big problem.]

The raids came a day before the National Organization for the Reform of Marijuana Laws (NORML) announced a poll that found overwhelming support for ending the DEA raids. The poll asked the question: "During the presidential campaign, Barack Obama said he would stop federal raids against medical marijuana providers in the 13 states where medical marijuana has become legal. Should President Obama keep his word to end such raids?"

More than two-to-one in all geographic, demographic, and political groups answered "yes." Overall, 72% of respondents said stop the raids.

DEA agents broke down doors and seized marijuana destined for patients as well as cash and computers. Several dispensary operators told California activist organizations that agents acted even more aggressively than usual.

"The conduct of the agents was unprofessional and vindictive. They call them 'investigations,' but they just go in there and steal medicine and money and smash things." President Obama and Attorney General Holder to take action to stop the medical marijuana raids now -- because patients and the people who serve them are suffering and being subjected to injustice now.

DEA agents raided four medical marijuana dispensaries in the Los Angeles area Tuesday, hitting two in Venice, one in Marina Del Rey, and one in Playa del Rey. The raids come nearly two weeks after President Obama took office and on the same day that Eric Holder was confirmed as head of the Justice Department, the agency that oversees DEA operations. They mark the second such incident taking place under the Obama administration, the first being a January 22nd raid of a medical marijuana dispensary in South Lake Tahoe.

Gieringer cited reports he had received that DEA agents destroyed surveillance cameras at at least one location, possibly destroyed a computer hard drive at another, and took bags of cash without counting it or providing a receipt from another. "Whose interest does that serve?" asked Gieringer. "And not counting the cash, that's a real no-no. This whole thing needs to be investigated; it's not serving any legitimate purpose. And they picked on places that were modest, well-controlled, legal under state law, and no trouble to anybody. That's pretty scummy." "A few months ago in Long Beach, while the federal agents were smashing video cameras, other cameras were recording them doing so and sending the images to an off-site server, so, in this case, at least, we have video evidence of them doing just what they are again accused of." "They go in with paramilitary gear, with flak jackets, automatic weapons, sometimes even wearing ski masks, destroy what's inside, and take medicine, money, computers, and patient records, and trash the place." "President Obama needs to show federal agencies who is boss," said DPA national affairs director Bill Piper. "If he doesn't put a halt to these raids, the DEA will continue to undermine his campaign promises."

We are asking Obama for a simple signature to end the raids. If one person dies in these raids the President has failed the American People. This is his watch and he shall be held responsible and accountable to the American People for the actions of the Federal Government.
