



Mises Was Champion of Right vs Wrong TRUTH NEEDS CHAMPIONS

Too many people like to imagine that in history, truth will prevail through sheer persuasive power. Sadly, this is not the case. Truth needs champions, in all walks of life.

Mises is one of those champions of truth, right vs. wrong. His book of 1912 condemned central banking, but nevertheless, a year later the United States had the Federal Reserve central banking system in place, followed by the Great Depression.

Mises warned against the dangers of socialism and mixed economies, but by the 1930s, every major economy in the world was being lorded over by socialists and fascists. He said that positivism in the social sciences was a snare and a delusion, but by the 1950s, the whole of the social sciences had embraced the positivist creed.

A phrase batted around in old Vienna was that Mises was the "last knight of liberalism," a phrase that suggests some nobility but also irrelevance, the certainty that he would never create a school of thought, and surely that his ideas had no future. They gossipers were wrong again, for today, we look around a world of burgeoning libertarian scholarship and activism in all walks of life.

Mises was wise enough to see through the dismissals of his work, and to know that history can turn on any detail. Belittled as anachronistic, Mises turns out to have a vast and growing presence in the world of 2008 as people of all walks of life now consider the relevance and practicality of Mises ideas, principles, and values.

During Mises's lifetime, some people believed that his prominence was due to the force of his personality. He was incredibly charming, impossibly sweet, and also tenacious and fantastically productive. He was a one-man global machine working on behalf of human liberty. He only had a few colleagues in carrying on the Misesian vision, and extending it in ways that inspired multitudes, but also in ways that not everyone liked.

When Mises died, the enemies of liberty on that day believed that they had something to rejoice about. Mr. Libertarian, and the dean of the American Law and individual sovereignty, was gone. They believed that history could move on without having to deal with the constant problem of the Misesian critique.

It was this realization, combined with the desire to do what was right, that inspires us to carry on with his legacy, for our efforts are still in the face of Tyrants and devils who hate the freedoms and liberties God Blessed upon American Citizens with a mandate to be ever vigilant or soon to lose it all to the dark forces that enslave the large majority of the World's peoples.

Mises' enemies had made a mistake. They all believed that the movement that was growing was being kept alive by force of his personality. What they underestimated was the power of his ideas. What his ideas needed were champions, people to carry on his work, to carry forth his vision in all ideological areas. He had worked not just on behalf of his own generation but on behalf of the many to come. He had given us a new understanding of what is right and wrong about the world, and a vision for what can be. That vision is not affected by his passing, because he left us his ideas and his inspiration, and a call for perpetuation and development into the future.

Who is the new Mises? It is a faulty question in many ways, because it assumes that there must be a living person with the same genius-level intellectual power in order for a movement [to page 4]





Gun Rights in National Parks

The Bush administration, after more than seven years, has finally issued regulations permitting the carrying of firearms in national parks. Gun owners will soon be able to carry firearms according to the laws of the state in which the park is located.

While not perfect, the proposed regulations, it's not clear (in the proposed regs) whether or not an individual will be able to engage in open carry on national park lands for the purpose of self-defense, which are likely to take effect at the end of June 2008, represent a sharp contrast with the steadfast refusal to allow for self-defense in national parks.

The bureaucrats responded after a crescendo of congressional activity, 47 Senators signed a letter to the Department of the Interior urging that the ban be removed.

In the House, there are now three bills that would open national parks to carrying firearms as regulated by the state in which the park is located.

I urge you to cosponsor Rep. Paul Broun's bill, H.R. 5646, which protects the Second Amendment rights of individuals to carry firearms and ammunition in units of the National Park System and the National Wildlife Refuge System. It also requires that hunting activities be a land use in all management plans for Federal land to the extent that such use is not clearly incompatible with the purposes for which the Federal land is managed.

Now that the Park Service has finally recognized that this is a good idea, there is no reason not to enact this into federal law so that the next president could not once again make it illegal to protect oneself with a gun in a national park.

Please let me know when you have cosponsored Rep. Broun's bill. Gun Owners of America will be keeping me posted.

US Supreme Court-Fascists

These 9 inferior justices of the U.S. Supreme Court are being asked to translate the 2nd Amendment right to keep and bear arms as being the a privilege and power of bureaucrats in the D.C. gun ban case of D.C. v. Heller, which argued that any gun ban -- no matter how sweeping -- could be constitutional if some court determines that it is "reasonable."

If the Supreme Court were to accept the Solicitor General's line of argument, D.C.'s categorical gun ban of virtually all self-defense firearms could well be found to be constitutional, even if attorneys in high offices acting as judges, say that the Second Amendment protects 'individual' rights."

The Solicitor General's suggestion that comprehensive gun bans are constitutional if some court determines they are "reasonable" was enthusiastically greeted by anti-gun zealots --Brady et al which praised Hawaii's anti gun rights laws [HRS 134] that unlawfully require registration before possession.

Thus, in contrast to other provisions in the Bill of Rights, which can only be trumped by 'compelling state interests,' the Second Amendment would be relegated to an inferior position at the lowest rung of the constitutional ladder, should Bush's Justice Department and Hawaii's Linda Lingle's A.G. prevail.

Bill of Rights 2nd Amendment: "A well regulated militia being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed."

Wake up militia! Use it , or lose it ! Got your gun, yet?

The goal of the founders of America was to restrict government within severe limits and to protect the rights of sovereign individuals. Government has NO rights!





From page 2:to grow and be effective, and to create a bridge to the current renaissance of American Law and individual sovereignty. Great minds like Mises, even when they have left us, they leave their ideas scattered over the earth like particles of gold, waiting to be picked up by anyone who is willing. There are people in all walks of life who seek to understand the world better; thousands of successors, each specializing in an occupational pursuit that suits his or her talent. American law must continue to be a mature movement. It will not be dominated by one or two deep thinkers. It will be populated by thousands upon thousands of dedicated intellectuals working in all aspects of life. They will be specialists. They will be professors, students, businesspeople, musicians, bloggers, homeschoolers, professionals, pastors, and there might even be a few political activists. What's important is that each is working to the best of his or her abilities to do good and fight evil. Truth needs champions, or the light will be turned to darkness.

Put simply, it was Mises who saved the ideas of liberty from extinction in the dark decades of the 1930s and 1940s. It took brilliance, bravery, and the willingness to make huge personal sacrifices. But his lifetime motto from Virgil sustained him: Do not give in to evil, but proceed ever more boldly against it.

Mises was a hero, while others fell away. He was an exemplar of academic courage in a century in which most intellectuals willingly served tyrannies of left and right. In Mises we find the genuine article, a creator who accomplished so much, a man of integrity who refused to bend his principles, no matter what the personal cost.

Even in the face of all these successes, however, we ask Why aren't all our efforts making a difference? What are we doing wrong? Are we just wasting our time with our publications, conferences, editorials? Have our educational efforts ever made any difference?

No state is liberal by nature, said Mises. Every state wants to control all. If it does not do so, the major reason is that freedom-minded intellectuals ARE making the difference.

Ideas matter. More than we know. We are, right now, stopping all kinds of evil that we do not see. Why haven't we won? Because we are not doing enough and our ranks are not big enough. We need to do what we are doing on ever-grander scales. We need to make ever-better arguments on behalf of liberty.

Daum was told that he was wasting his time, but he knew better. He knew that socialism, central banking, interventionism, and high taxation were policies that would fail to promote the social good, and that insofar as people saw this, they could not be permanent. He saw beyond his own lifetime. And we should too.

There is a reason we are born when we are. For what? For doing right, promoting good, keeping evil at bay, advancing the well-being of society as individuals. To the extent that we enjoy prosperity and peace today it is because those who came before us did what they were supposed to do on our behalf.

Today, it is our turn, and we must bear the burden. We must do what is right, while we still have time. There is not a moment of our lives to waste. Freedom is a rarity in the history of the world, and it comes about only when it has champions. Let us be those champions today, for as long as we are granted breath on earth.
