Memorial Day Observed in Kaunakakai

The annual Memorial Day Observance was held on May 26 by Veterans of Foreign Wars Kenneth A. Misaki Post 3870. VFW Post Commander George Harada opened the ceremonies. Pule was said by Post Chaplain Adolphus Lankford. As the Little League game at the ball park paused and players and fans stood with Memorial day observers, students of O Hina I Ka Malama once again offered a stirring National Anthem and Hawai'i Pono 'I before the parade of flags and lei were presented to adorn the memorial. As David Nanod read the roll call of Molokai soldiers lost in World War II, Korean Conflict, and VietNam War, Albert Pu tolled the bell. A colorful release of red, white and blue pigeons by Clay Adachi brought beauty in flight in memory of veterans.



Guest Speaker US Congresswoman Mazie Hirono spoke of her vote on the previous Thursday in support of the troops serving in Iraq and the Middle East. She spoke of the need for support services for returning service personnel and the high cost of the Iraq War. Hirono also spoke of the bill to pay benefits for World War II Filipino veterans. She also mentioned the Congressional Record interview of Molokai resident Alice Kono who served as an interpreter during the second World War. She echoed of all, the prayer for bringing home the troops from the Middle East safely.

Accompanied by musician Ilse Borden, Bo Mahoe and Larry Helm led veterans and the audience in rousing singing of the anthems of the five military branches. The ceremonies concluded with TAPS played by Ilse Borden and the singing of Hawai'i Aloha led by Larry Helm. Paina cooked by the Molokai Vets Center followed the Memorial Day observance. Before the 9:30am observance, Congresswoman Hirono met with Molokai Veterans Center members about the complexities of funding for a Molokai Veterans Center.

VA "face-to-face" Assistance for Molokai Veterans to Resume

WASHINGTON, D.C. U.S. Senator Daniel K. Akaka (D-HI), Chairman of the Senate Committee on Veterans Affairs, announced today that the VA regional office in Honolulu has agreed to provide face-to-face benefits information and claims assistance for neighbor island veterans and their families in quarterly visits to Molokai and monthly field visits to Maui, Kauai and the Big Island. VA took action as a result of a letter from Chairman Akaka to VA Under Secretary for Benefits Daniel L. Cooper. Akaka expressed his concern that neighbor island visits had been curtailed, asked for an explanation, and encouraged Cooper to reinstate the visits.

These field visits will allow neighbor island veterans who can not travel to Oahu for physical or financial reasons an opportunity to get the face-to-face assistance in obtaining benefits and services they need and deserve, Akaka said. I commend Under Secretary Cooper for taking action to provide personal access to veterans on those islands.

Veterans are encouraged to make appointments for assistance during the monthly, or quarterly, VA visit to their islands.

The VA has released the following schedule:

Molokai: June 15 (553-8387). Quarterly.

US Citizens vs Police State Lists

Elizabeth Kushigian never had a problem flying back-and-forth to Costa Rica, on business. But she suddenly found it impossible to re-enter the United States without being ordered into a special isolation room for extra scrutiny interrogations.

U.S. Senator Ted Kennedy, who himself was fingered by a watch list in 2004, eventually sent a letter signed by the head of Immigration and Customs for Kushigian who was one of the lucky ones: Winning even a tacit acknowledgement that she was on a list is a rare victory over the federal homeland security bureaucracy.

There is a growing number of hundreds of thousands of American citizens whose lives have been touched by a slew of government watch lists proliferating with little oversight or redress mechanisms since 9/11 -- they've stigmatized and inconvenienced thousands of others whose names happen to be similar to an entry.

The issue returned to national debate last week after one of the nation's most respected constitutional law professors was told by an airline official that he'd been placed on a watch list for his criticism of President Bush.

Walter F. Murphy, McCormick Professor of Jurisprudence Emeritus at Princeton University, found himself unable to check in curbside at a New Mexico airport. American Airlines told him it was because he was on a "terrorist watch list."

Murphy said that one clerk asked 'Have you been in any peace marches? We ban a lot of people from flying for that,' recalls Murphy. "I said, 'No, but I did give a speech criticizing George Bush,' and he said, 'That will do it.'"

The evidence remains thin that Murphy was actually on a watch list -- he was able to get a boarding pass on his return trip -- but the incident shows how the watch list programs have put their Nazi imprint on Americans. The NCIC database is queried nearly any time a cop makes an arrest or pulls someone over for speeding. A 2005 Inspector General report found the center's database of hundreds of thousand of records was plagued with technical difficulties and inaccurate entries.

Bush's America looks more and more like the Soviet Union, Nazi Germany or even, dare I say it, the Saddam-era of Iraq. **Our troops die for this !?!?**



Welcome to Lingle's New Police State

In the old days in The United States of America, a journalist didn't have to get permission to conduct an interview in a public place. But this is a new America, a place where armed security agents watch your every move and require their permission to exercise what used to be a first amendment right.

I've been a television news reporter for 33 years. I first began covering news when Richard Nixon was about to resign. I've gone to airports many times to film- yes we used to use film- and lately to video-tape and interview famous and infamous people getting on and getting off airplanes.

I've been around a while and I've covered a lot of stories at airports. Things have changed.

I want to tell you what happened to me today (May 17, 2007) at Honolulu International Airport. I was assigned to meet and interview Nainoa Thompson, navigator of the Polynesian Voyaging Canoe Hokule'a. He and his crew were departing for Japan to sail their Hawaiian canoe on the final leg of an historic voyage. It was arranged for our crew to meet them on the sidewalk outside the check-in area. All I needed was a quick couple of sound bites with Nainoa and two of the young crew members who were leaving to fulfill a cultural mission of goodwill and Aloha.

I arrived with a news photographer at the Honolulu Airport and we paid to park in the parking garage. We walked to the public sidewalk in front of the check-in area where we met Nainoa and the young crewmembers. We turned on the camera and began talking with them.

This is something I have done at least a hundred times over the past 33 years. In the USA a reporter used to be able to go to any public place and interview someone without being roused by authorities.

This was not a restricted area. We did not attempt to board an airplane, or walk past the security gate, or get out on to a runway. We were not taping near any TSA checkpoint. We were out on the sidewalk at a public facility.

While I was interviewing an 18-year old Hawaiian, asking how he felt about taking a voyage on a Hawaiian canoe several uniformed security agents walked up and stopped the interview. They insisted that we cease videotaping. They demanded to know what we were doing, who authorized us to be there, and whether we had permission.

EXCUSE ME???

In the United States of America that I grew up in a reporter was allowed to interview anyone in any public place, about anything, at any time, without requesting or having to be granted permission by uniformed goons. Pardon me- I mean low wage security guards.

I snapped, and perhaps I should apologize to these poor rent-a-cops. I did not say it to their faces, but as I turned to go to the airport security office I did mutter an obscenity: "This is the f&#^ing United States. You don't need permission to do an interview in a public place. This is not supposed to be a goddamned fascist state!"

They heard me. Now I was asking for trouble. They called for backups.

Several more armed security guards surrounded my cameraman. He told them, "It's not big deal; we're just trying to interview some people about sailing on the Hokule'a."

I went to the security office and got "permission" from airport authorities to do something that is supposed to be guaranteed under our (former) Constitution.

It saddens me to see America slipping into a state that allows armed security guards to demand "authorization" for something that used to be taken for granted. I never before had to get "permission" from "authorities" to talk to someone in a public place. I brought this up in the security office when they were so graciously "granting" me permission to resume my interview. A security guard in front of a bank of television surveillance monitors told me, "Things are different after 911."

I wonder- what does a well known television reporter interviewing young Hawaiian kids in a public place about sailing on a canoe have to do with 911? How is this a threat?

And the saddest thing for me is this- young people growing up today will simply submit. They won't even remember a time when a reporter- or any citizen- could go to an airport and talk to someone without having to get permission from authorities. ---- Dick Allgire, KITV News, Honolulu

May Day Mahem by POLICE in Los Angeles

A Fox News reporter heard riot cops say, Better hustle, it s time to tussle, as they moved in on people with batons and loaded weapons. Well over 100 riot cops, including 30 to 40 shooting pellet guns and rubber bullets began attacking everyone in the park. They fired many times directly at people, many of whom could not get away from the police onslaught.

One eyewitness Ernesto Arce, described the scene: Without warning, cops descended into a park full of families, homeless and handicapped individuals and street cart vendors. They were merciless. For the next 30 minutes, hundreds of activists and bystanders were shot, beaten by night sticks and run out of the park. The police had no intention of entertaining requests from people who were not able to move quickly enough. They were forcefully hit on the legs until they were immobile. I witnessed many people who were shot at from the back. Children and entire families were being violently pushed or beaten. An elderly woman cried out for help but no one went back in the face of fast-approaching SWAT police.

Not anyone had a gun to defend themselves against these paramilitary government run goons. Next time, everyone take guns to the park for protection.

Vets Protest War: Courage to Resist

SACRAMENTO, CA (May 30, 2007) An Iraq War veteran who insists on remaining anonymous as "only a representative" of his fallen comrades began walking laps around the state capitol building Monday morning at 8:00 am. Fifty-nine hours later, he is still walking. Although some on the scene are now summing up his condition as a health crisis due in large part to weather extremes, he has told supporters he will not rest until he has finished walking laps for every U.S. service person killed in Iraq.



As the unnamed vet carries the name of a different fallen comrade around the capitol with each lap, others carry the names Iraqis killed during the U.S. attack on their country. At this time the vet has completed over 330 nearly half-mile loops around the building, nearly one lap for each of the 350 troops from California killed in Iraq.

Come out to support this action at a press conference tomorrow morning (Thursday, May 31) in front of the Capitol Building on L Street at 12th Street, Sacramento.

The Iraq War vet served in Iraq during the initial invasion in 2003 as an Army medic attached to an infantry unit. During yesterdays early morning Memorial Day kick off press conference, and for some of the laps, he was joined by Patrick Sheehan, father of Army Spc. Casey Sheehan who was killed in Iraq in April 2004, and Caseys younger brother Andy. The unnamed vet has been supported by members of Veterans for Peace Chapter 87, Military Families Speak Out, Sacramento Coalition to End the War, Iraq Veterans Against the War, and Courage to Resist.

Jailed for upholding law at Guantnamo

On May 18, Lieutenant Commander Matthew Diaz was sentenced to six months in a Navel brig and removal from the Navy for courageously upholding the constitution of the United States. Apparently this is a very serious crime in America today. Lt. Cmdr. Diaz is actually counting himself lucky, as the 41-year-old officer with 19-years of service to the U.S. Navy faced a possible 14 years in prison.

Diaz was a military attorney assigned to investigate abuses of prisoners at Guantnamo, the legal black hole dungeon that operates outside of domestic and international law according to the Bush administration. Taking this assignment seriously not only some-what predictably ended his military career; it might have landed himself in prison until the year 2021.

On orders from Defense Secretary Donald Rumsfeld, the U.S. had refused to release the names of the prisoners that were being held at Guantnamo. The U.S. continued to stonewall all requests for this information even after a federal court ruled that the names must be turned over.

Diaz took action to uphold the law, knowing the risks involved. Concerned about this abuse of human rights, Diaz sent a Valentines Day card to the Center for Constitutional Rights in February 2005. The year earlier, the U.S. Supreme Court ruled in support of C.C.R.s right to represent these prisoners. Included with Diazs card, printed in very small type, was a list of about 550 names of prisoners held at Guantnamo.

My oath as a commissioned officer is to the Constitution of the United States, Diaz told the Dallas Morning News. Im not a criminal. I had observed the stonewalling, the obstacles we continued to place in the way of the attorneys, Diaz told the media before his sentencing. I knew my time was limited. ... I had to do something.

What is illegal, he said, is the Bush administration's prosecution of the war on terror. He accused officials of violating international law, such as the Geneva Conventions on the humane treatment of war prisoners, and the Constitution's guarantee of due process.

"I felt it was the right decision, the moral decision, the decision that was required by international law," Diaz said. "No matter how the conflict was identified, we were to treat them in accordance with Geneva, and it just wasn't being done."

IRS Attacks 2nd Former Agent

2nd Federal IRS agent prosecuted by IRS [Are you next?]


The goal of the founders of America was to restrict government within severe limits and to protect the rights of sovereign individuals. Government has NO rights!

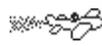


