Metal Recycling Opens July 1 at the Molokai Landfill !

Reports from the landfill workers is that we can start unloading our collections of old stoves, water heaters, cars, junk metals, batteries and tires to the Molokai Landfill Recycling center.

FIRST, make an **appointment by phone 336-0899**, then, you can drop off recycleable metal opalas on any Tuesday 8am-3pm and Saturday 8am to 11 am.

If you do not make an appointment, you will have to wait in line until those with appointments go first.

Phone Book Recycle Winners

This year, the Maui County School Telephone Book Recycling Contest saw 10 Maui schools and three on Molokai participating. Lanai High and Elementary School held its own contest and earned \$250 for collecting 1,767 pounds of books. Altogether, Maui County schools collected more than 37,000 pounds of books, to prevent from being put in county landfills.

On Molokai, Kaunakakai Elementary School collected the most with 2,465 books recycled, \$400; Kualapuu Public Conversion Charter School was second with 880 books, \$200; and Molokai High School was third, 97 books, \$100.

On Maui, Baldwin High was first with 8,366 pounds recycled, \$700 earned. Hawaiian Telcom Yellow Pages partnered with Aloha Recycling on Maui and Mako Trucking on Molokai for the contest, from Feb. 18 to March 29.

Shipping Costs to Rise Interisland as Young Brothers asks PUC Rate Increase

As it pays for equipment upgrades, Wages

The Young Brothers Files Application with the Public Utilities Commission for Zone Increase of 5.5 Percent, Requests August 1, 2008 Effective Date

Under the PUC Decision and Order number 24139, the company has rate flexibility within a range, called a "zone of reasonableness." The proposed zone increase does not include or reflect the increased cost of fuel, which is covered in the company's separate fuel price adjustment.

"Young Brothers has kept increases to its operational expenses low despite cost pressures in many sectors and is limiting its 2008 rate increase request to zone of reasonableness limits rather than seeking a higher rate increase through a general rate case," said Roy Catalani, vice president of strategic planning and government affairs for Young Brothers. "Among other things, we will pay higher labor costs in 2008 while we remain committed to our 10-year, \$186 million capital reinvestment plan to develop and maintain essential transportation infrastructure. Young Brothers will continue to make substantial investments in vessels, containers, cargo handling equipment and information systems to benefit our customers throughout the state," he added.

In March 2006, Young Brothers announced that it was embarking on a 10-year capital reinvestment plan totaling \$186 million. In 2006, it made capital expenditures of \$38 million, followed by an additional \$30.5 million in 2007 and a projected \$19.5 million in 2008. Catalani stated that Young Brothers is reinvesting in its Hawaii operations and infrastructure an amount that is far in excess of the operating income that it is projected to earn over the 10-year plan period.

In 2008, Young Brothers will embark on several major customer service enhancements, including placing into service its second and third new barges (with the fourth new barge coming into service in 2009). These four state-of-the-art barges, which are expected to be in service over a period of 25 to 30 years are 40 percent larger than the older barges.

The new barges have new, more fuel efficient hull forms that allow for increased cargo load and cargo growth without increasing fuel consumption for the towing tug and also will substantially reduce air emissions. These vessels are part of Young Brothers' larger strategic plan that includes partnering with the state on plans to improve and create more efficient facilities in ports statewide.

Catalani said that Young Brothers will maintain the good value of inter-island shipping. With the proposed rate increase, for example, shipping 2,000 pounds of locally grown cabbage (shipped via refrigerated pallet) will cost about \$63; 2,000 pounds of frozen chicken will cost about \$90; 40 cubic feet of canned goods (about 1,920 cans of soup) will cost about \$31; and a 60-cubic foot pallet of beverages (about 495 six-packs) will cost about \$41.





Mexico may even have it worse right now. In 2006 and 2007 roughly 4,000 people have been murdered in drug prohibition violence, and police are among the many suspects.

While police corruption and drug trade violence have certainly taken their toll on our country here in the north, we should by no means rule out the possibility that things could get even worse.

Intelligent people understand that it is prohibition which causes drug trade violence, and that America and the World would be better off with some form of drug legalization. Every scenario has both pros and cons. But they all have in common that they are preferable to prohibition.

The victims of the drug laws don't deserve what is being done to them. Since our politicians are mostly too scared to talk about this, it is therefore up to us to press for drug policy changes that help people and stop the drug war violence and police corruption. It is only an unfortunate matter of how many lives get ruined by so called law enforcement activities that net cops federal grant money.

Are the DARE police, MPD chief Thomas Phillips, asking your children to report you to police medical marijuana use?

The goal of the founders of America was to restrict government within severe limits and to protect the rights of sovereign individuals. Government has NO rights!







Drug War: Just A Bad SHOW

Former DEA agent: "Drug war all a show" that gets violent, deadly by Paul Kirk, Staff Reporter

"The drug war's a sham," said former Drug Enforcement Agent Mike Levine at the Holmes Student Center. Levine hinted that those in the DEA who come too close to the political reality of the drug war sometimes mysteriously lose their lives. He recalled the time a former agent, Sandy Barrio, was accused by the DEA of drug smuggling. He died of strychnine poisoning while awaiting trial, but Barrio's death certificate was fixed to read that he died of asphyxiation on a peanut butter sandwich.

"I threw my life to the winds believing in the war against drugs. If I died, I believed I was dying for a just cause," Levine said. "Later, I realized the reality of what I was doing never quite matched what the public was seeing."

Levine cited a mission which he followed into Asia during the Vietnam War. The bodies of dead U.S. soldiers were being used for containers to ship heroin back to the United States. Levine investigated the deal all the way to the production line where he was stopped by his superiors.

Levine said he experienced such evasion techniques by his superiors throughout his career. "DEA was designed to put itself out of business [by stopping drugs] but that doesn't happen. The opposite happens. It's always 'we need more funding,'" he said.

"The drug war programs are ill-conceived. All media and politicians are just parrots. It's all a show. 'We need more money. We're going to get these guys,'" Levine said, mimicking the politicians. "The U.S. drug war is the laughing stock of South America."

Levine said the United States needs to direct the money designated for the drug war toward domestic problems which breed the drug problem. He said he believes family and church involvement at a social level is the key, instead of federal dollars and violent police tactics.
