## IRS and FRB's Not Government

Federal Reserve Banks are "independent, privately owned and locally controlled corporations", and there is not sufficient "federal government control over 'detailed physical performance' and 'day to day operation'" of the Federal Reserve Bank for it to be considered a federal agency:

Lewis v. United States, 680 F.2d 1239 (1982)

John L. Lewis, Plaintiff/Appellant, v. United States of America, Defendant/Appellee. No. 80-5905 United States Court of Appeals, Ninth Circuit. Submitted March 2, 1982. Decided April 19, 1982. As Amended June 24, 1982. Plaintiff, who was injured by vehicle owned and operated by a federal reserve bank, brought action alleging jurisdiction under the Federal Tort Claims Act. The United States District Court for the Central District of California, David W. Williams, J., dismissed holding that federal reserve bank was not a federal agency within meaning of Act and that the court therefore lacked subject-matter jurisdiction. Appeal was taken. The Court of Appeals, Poole, Circuit Judge, held that federal reserve banks are not federal instrumentalities for purposes of the Act, but are independent, privately owned and locally controlled corporations.

## CANCER ALERT: Tooth Paste/Hand Soaps

Dozens of toothpastes sold at supermarkets are at the centre of a cancer alert today. Anti-bacterial cleaning products, including dishwashing liquid and handwash, are also affected because researchers have discovered that **TRICLOSAN**, a chemical in the products, can react with chlorinated drinking water to produce chloroform gas. If inhaled, chloroform can cause depression, liver problems, cancer, and death.

Researchers in the US found that the chloroform produced when soap containing the chemical mixes with chlorinated water can be absorbed through the skin or inhaled.

Professor Peter Vikesland, of Virginia Tech University, who carried out the research, said: "This is the first work that we know of that suggests that consumer products, such as antimicrobial soap, can produce significant quantities of chloroform." He has called for governments around the world to regulate the chemical more closely.

## Kaapuni Vows to Defend Constitutional Rights as Supreme Court Rules Police Don't need no stinking warrant, or to knock

In state chanceries: At best, you are hoping that the crooked politicians and judges will somehow give you a fair trial by jury of your peers and do you justice....if you just know your place and let them have absolute power over the court. Wake up People, its Not going to happen that way!

Very early one morning, the Hans Kaapuni family was subjected to a violent raid on their Ranch Camp home above Kaunakakai conducted by Maui Police Department officers who crashed their sliding glass door and rushed inside guns drawn where the family was still asleep. They claimed to have a valid warrant to search, but did not show the required affidavit, and the address was wrong, and the description of the house erroneous, nor did they leave an inventory of the money and jewelry they took after their drug sniffing dogs found no drugs.

Kaapuni says this is the fifth time being raided, and no drugs, and he wants the harassment stopped, and the deadly danger and terror to his family stopped. He wants police to respect the 4th Amendment rights of his family. So, he finally sued. He lost, when the federal judge Mollway took the case from the jury and ruled against this American family and for the police state.

Kaapuni says he plans to appeal this unjust verdict by a judge and her violation of his right to a trial by a jury of his peers.

Maui County confirmed that on June 14, 2006, the Maui County Police Department prevailed in a civil jury trial in federal district court in Honolulu. Judge Susan Mollway granted County's Motion for Judgment as a Matter of Law at the close of the plaintiffs' case in Kaapuni v.

Carlton Helm because she felt that the plaintiffs did not provide sufficient evidence for a reasonable jury to find for the plaintiffs, even though that decision was to be put before the jury. The jury was dismissed.

This was a so called Directed Verdict by the judge instead of a trial by jury. Kaapuni said he suspected a conspiracy when judge Mollway called him and tried to discourage him from a trial, then later said it would be a very short trial.

County attorneys Moana Lutey, Lauren Martin, and Richard B. Rost represented the police officers. Arthur Ross and Rory Soares Toomey represented plaintiffs.

[MAN note: The specter of impromptu armed dawn raids based on the testimony of shadowy neighborhood informants wouldn't look out of place in Communist East Germany but we are told by police and politicians and the U.S. Supreme Court that it is the new Amerika, the new Hawaii Lingle Police State, and that we should shut up and accept it. Hans Kaapuni does not accept it, and neither do most citizens of Hawaii. Unfortunately, things are getting worse as the U.S. Supreme court ruled, on the same day as Kaapuni's case, that police do NOT have to knock and I.D. and wait 30 seconds before crashing into a residence, and that police can also use evidenced they gather even if obtained without a warrant. This is in my opinion a declaration of war. I expect this ruling will lead to more frequent physical encounters between police and innocent individuals who are abruptly surprised by the police acting like home invading criminals.

I do appreciate the danger that the police practically invite while waiting at the door for a violent criminal to welcome them into his home. With this in mind, substantial evidence should be required at the time the search warrant is granted that the target of a No Knock Search is in fact a violent criminal to provide protection for American Citizens against all kinds of abuses by militarized police.

Is a No Knock Search necessary to prevent a criminal from destroying evidence? That is very likely true, but the Legislators should require the individuals requesting such a search warrant to be held accountable, pay damages civil and punitive to the victims of the raid, if the search for evidence turns up empty, as in the Kaapuni case, and thousands more. This would encourage such searches to be limited to cases that the requesting police are so certain that the no knock raid and search is needed and will turn up the expected evidence that they are willing to risk their careers, and their freedom.

Prosecutors argue that innocent victims can seek remedy for police terrorism by means of a civil lawsuit. However, the Kaapuni case and countless others are proof that is no remedy, in spite of the fact that the Constitution for the United States of America guarantees everyone their right to present, without impediment by officers of the court, their evidence of injury due to neglect and/or wrongdoing by the government home invaders to a jury of his peers which is empowered and obligated to investigate, judge and remedy legitimate complaints against such police state behavior. —The MAN]

**CRIMINALLY PROSECUTE**

**NEWSPAPERS, SAYS Security CHAIR**

The chairman of the House Homeland Security Committee urged the Bush administration today to seek criminal charges against newspapers that reported on a secret financial-monitoring program used to trace terrorists.

King cited The New York Times in particular for publishing a story last week that the Treasury Department was working with the CIA to examine messages within a massive international database of money-transfer records. He said he would write Attorney General Alberto Gonzales urging him to "begin an investigation and prosecution of The New York Times ~ the reporters, the editors and the publisher."

"We're at war, and for the Times to release information about secret operations and methods is treasonous," King told The Associated Press.

Executive editor, Bill Keller, said editors had listened closely to the government's arguments for withholding the information, but "remain convinced that the administration's extraordinary access to this vast repository of international financial data, however carefully targeted use of it may be, is a matter of public interest." The New York Times in December also disclosed a secret domestic wiretapping program.

US AG Gonzales said the First Amendment right of a free press should not be absolute when it comes to national security. [WRONG! That is FASCIST BS !]



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the STATE OF HAWAII, PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION ("Commission"), will hold public meetings relating to the Transmittal of YOUNG BROTHERS, LIMITED ("YB"), filed on April 13, 2006, for approval to discontinue its less than container load service for the transportation of cargo to and from Kahului Harbor, island of Maui.

YB is a water carrier authorized to transport property by barge between the islands of Oahu, Hawaii, Kauai, Maui, Molokai, and Lanai. YB's intrastate water carrier operations are subject to the Commission's regulation. YB currently consolidates and deconsolidates cargo at its ports of call for shippers that do not place their cargo in containers.

YB proposes to discontinue its less than container load service for the transportation of cargo to and from Kahului Harbor in order to address the critical shortage of available harbor space at that port of call. YB explains that its proposal, if approved by the Commission: (1) will mean that the consolidation and deconsolidation of less than container load cargo bound for or leaving Kahului Harbor will have to occur at off-harbor sites located away from Kahului Harbor; and (2) motor carriers of property are or will be available as consolidators/freight forwarders. YB seeks to implement its proposal effective from January 1, 2007.

## Iraq War Recruiting FILIPINO MERCENARIES

Manila Sun Star MALACANANG on Sunday said Congress can go ahead if it wants to investigate the alleged recruitment of "Mercenaries" to Iraq by security firm Blackwater USA. Executive Secretary Eduardo Ermita said "it's within the prerogative of Congress" if it wants to investigate the recruitment but he said he does not know how lawmakers will do it because Congress adjourned last June 8. Muntinlupa City Representative Rufino Biazon has said that he is - mulling the filing of a resolution seeking an inquiry into the hiring and training of Filipinos for Deployment as Mercenaries in Iraq.

Ermita insisted that he does not know anything about the Blackwater deal, whose local counterpart - Sotelyst Solutions has a pending application for the lease of the one-hectare firing range at the Subic Freeport. Reports said Blackwater recruits have been conducting practice firing at the Clark Special Economic Zone (CSEZ) on weekends. Ermita said the reports are still "speculative" because it's not yet approved by the Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA). The Communist Party of the Philippines (CPP) denounced the US for hiring Filipino mercenaries to fight its wars in Iraq and other countries. New People's Army (NPA) spokesman Gregorio "Ka Roger" Rosal said hiring Filipino civilians to provide support services for the US' war in Iraq and other countries is bad enough and should be discouraged, but - "hiring Filipino soldiers of fortune - to fight in US wars of aggression and terror against other countries is even worse and deserves nothing but condemnation." - Rosal said the establishment of Blackwater's recruitment center in the Philippines stemmed from the mounting casualties of US military personnel that have triggered severe criticism, massive protests and plunging ratings for US President George W. Bush. He said the US has also turned to Third World countries to be able to cut costs as hired Filipino mercenaries are paid only US\$60,000-US\$80,000 a year, - half of what it pays American mercenaries with equivalent qualifications and assignments. He also denounced Malacañang for "secretly endorsing" Blackwater's entry at the Subic Freeport. "(National Security Adviser) Norberto Gonzales has again - been caught lying through his teeth - - for denying any knowledge of Blackwater's presence," he added. Rosal said he finds it incredible for Gonzales not to have known that Malacañang had even facilitated Blackwater's entry by sending one of its staff, Bong Cuevas, to secure SBMA manager Fil Salonga's approval of the project. He warned that hiring Filipino mercenaries to fight alongside the US Army in Iraq and elsewhere could serve as a magnet for attacks against the Philippines and Filipinos abroad.

He added that Filipino mercenaries could be used by the US as "proxy armies" in fighting Philippine revolutionary forces and supporters. Rosal's view is echoed by the Union of Filipino Foreign Service Officers (Uniffors), a group of career diplomats, said in its weblog (uniffors.com), Uniffors said Blackwater's facilities or its "graduates" may be used by the Arroyo government in employing "non-traditional soldiers - a.k.a. mercenaries in the local war against terrorism." - It said that Gonzales is "downplaying" its presence in the Philippines and that "he's the biggest liar in Arroyo's Cabinet." It said the recruitment can be tied up with the new security arrangement between the US and the Philippines which covers "non-traditional" concerns.

WASHINGTON (AP) - A music video posted to the Internet, telling a tale about a U.S. Marine killing members of an Iraqi family, is being condemned by an Islamic group and investigated by the Marine Corps. The four-minute video, called "Hadji Girl," appears to be sung by a Marine in front of a cheering audience. The lyrics talk about the Marine gunning down members of an Iraqi woman's family after they confront him with automatic weapons.

Lt. Col. Scott Fazekas, a spokesman for the Marines, said Tuesday that the Marines were aware of a video posted on the Internet that "purports to show a Marine singing an insensitive song about Iraqis." Fazekas said officials don't know the identity of the singer or whether he is in the military.

The song was "inappropriate and contrary to the high standards expected of all Marines," Fazekas said. He said Marine officers are looking into the matter.

Nihad Awad, executive director of the Council on American-Islamic Relations, said that in light of recent allegations of atrocities committed by Marines in Haditha and other towns in Iraq, the video should be investigated by the Pentagon and Congress.

"The inappropriate actions of a few individuals should not be allowed to tarnish the reputation of all American military personnel," said Awad.

The video was posted anonymously on the <<http://www.youtube.com/web/>><http://www.youtube.comWeb> site, but was removed. It is still available on CAIR's web site. A Hadji is a pilgrim who journeys to Mecca, but CAIR said the word has often been used as a disparaging term by U.S. troops in Iraq.

"The video is not reflective of the tremendous sacrifices and dedication demonstrated, on a daily basis, by tens of thousands of Marines who have assisted the Iraqi people in gaining their freedom," Fazekas said. "We agree with the executive director of the Council on American -Islamic Relations that the inappropriate actions of a few individuals should not tarnish the reputation of all American military personnel."

The singer is shown playing a guitar and singing about meeting an Iraqi woman and then being confronted by her brother and father, who have guns. The lyrics describe the Marine pulling the woman's little sister in front of him and watching blood spray from her head. He then sings about blowing the father and brother "to eternity." Defense officials are investigating allegations that U.S. Marines massacred as many as two dozen unarmed civilians in Haditha last November. Another probe is under way into charges that U.S. troops pulled an unarmed Iraqi man from his home in Hamandiya in late April and shot him to death without provocation.

## EMINENT DOMAIN RESTRICTED

On the one-year anniversary last week of the controversial Supreme Court decision expanding the government's power of eminent domain, President Bush issued an executive order preventing federal agencies from seizing private property except for public projects such as hospitals or roads.

The Supreme Court ruled last June in *Kelo v. City of New London* the municipal government could seize the homes and businesses of residents to facilitate the building of an office complex that would provide economic benefits to the area and more tax revenue to the city. The seizure was for private development and not for "public use," such as a highway or bridge.

Pres. Bush's new Executive Order reads in part: By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, and to strengthen the rights of the American people against the taking of their private property, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Policy. It is the policy of the United States to protect the rights of Americans to their private property, including by limiting the taking of private property by the Federal Government to situations in which the taking is for public use, with just compensation, and for the purpose of benefiting the general public and not merely for the purpose of advancing the economic interest of private parties to be given ownership or use of the property taken.

Sec. 2. Implementation. (a) The Attorney General shall:

(i) issue instructions to the heads of departments and agencies to implement the policy set forth in section 1 of this order; and

(ii) monitor takings by departments and agencies for compliance with the policy set forth in section 1 of this order.

(b) Heads of departments and agencies shall, to the extent permitted by law:

(i) comply with instructions issued under subsection (a)(i); and

Sec. 3. Specific Exclusions. Nothing in this order shall be construed to prohibit a taking of private property by the Federal Government, that otherwise complies with applicable law, for the purpose of:

(a) public ownership or exclusive use of the property by the public, such as for a public medical facility, roadway, park, forest, governmental office building, or military reservation;

Doug Kendall, executive director of the Community Rights Counsel, said he's not aware of any federal government agency that takes property for economic development, and he opined that the order as a "political move" by Pres. Bush.

White House spokeswoman Dana Perino said the executive order put the federal government on record opposing eminent domain for merely economic development purposes.

"The president is a strong supporter of private property rights," she said.

Since the *Kelo* decision, an avalanche of property confiscations have followed similar to these: Oakland, Calif.: A week after the *Kelo* ruling, Oakland city officials used eminent domain to evict John Revelli from the downtown tire shop his family has owned since 1949. Revelli and a neighboring business owner had refused to sell their property to make way for a new housing development. Said Revelli of his fight with the City, "We thought we'd win, but the Supreme Court took away my last chance."

Boston, Mass.: Two days after the *Kelo* decision, Boston City Council President Michael Flaherty called on the mayor of Boston to seize South Boston waterfront property from unwilling sellers for a private development project.

\* Richmond Heights, Mo.: City officials are taking bids to demolish 200 homes in the Hadley Township Neighborhood, just to turn the land over to a private developer who will build more homes.

\* Ventor City, N.J.: Mayor Tim Kreischer wants to demolish 126 buildings - mom-and-pop shops, \$200,000 homes, and apartments - to erect luxury condos, high-end specialty stores, and a parking garage.

## ANIMAL RIGHTS NO FUR on POLO reports PETA

Polo Ralph Lauren to Drop Fur From Items

NEW YORK ~ Polo Ralph Lauren Corp. said late Thursday that it is eliminating fur from all of its apparel and home collections, starting with the holiday 2006 season.

In a press release, the New York-based fashion house said that fur had only been used "on a limited basis as an accent in some collections."

"We are publicly announcing this decision because the use of fur has been under review internally and we feel that the time is right to take this action," the company said in a statement.

The move by Polo Ralph Lauren represents the first major designer house to abandon fur since designer Calvin Klein did so in the mid-1990s, according to animal rights group People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals, which was involved in negotiations with Polo Ralph Lauren since March.

"This is one of the biggest victories in the fur campaign," said Dan Mathews, vice president at PETA.

PETA, known for disrupting fashion shows, and storming Seventh Avenue fashion houses, has been mounting pressure on other designer fashion brands, including Donna Karan International and luxury goods brand Burberry Group PLC.

Late last year, J. Crew Group Inc. stopped selling fur after PETA launched a boycott campaign and staged protests outside the retailer's doors nationwide.

"Ralph Lauren clothes have always been elegant, but now you can feel comfortable inside and out knowing that the company has made this compassionate decision," said Ingrid Newkirk, president of PETA.

As part of its initiative, Polo Ralph Lauren will donate 1,200 new units of women's clothing containing fur to charitable organizations, which will give them to an international relief organization for distribution to those in need

## Letter to Editor

Dear Mr. Mueller, FBI Director

I understand that recently the FBI joined with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives in conducting a raid on a manufacturing business in Montana. Reports indicate that in the course of questioning, the FBI seemed concerned about the manufacturer's associates, including myself, Aaron Zelman, and my organization, Jews for the Preservation of Firearms Ownership, and about Jews and guns in general. The FBI referred to these as "persons of interest."

While I do not consider yourself to be "of interest" to me, Mr. Mueller, the FBI is, for two reasons.

First, I would like to draw your attention to <http://www.jpfo.org/doddletter.pdf>, which is a photocopy of a 1968 letter from congressional law librarian Lewis C. Coffin to then-Senator Thomas Dodd. The letter, introduced as evidence (exhibit #62) before the congressional subcommittee investigating juvenile delinquency in 1968, reveals that Senator Dodd had in his possession a copy -- in German -- of the original text of the Nazi Weapons Law of 1938 \_prior to the drafting of the US 1968 Gun Control Act\_.

As demonstrated in our book, \_"Gun Control": Gateway to Tyranny\_, this is extremely significant because Senator Dodd assisted in the writing of the GCA, and the final version of the GCA is eerily similar to the above-referenced Nazi Weapons Law. Related, please see [www.jpfo.org/declassifieddocs.pdf](http://www.jpfo.org/declassifieddocs.pdf), a June 7, 2006 article entitled, "Declassified Documents Shed New Light on US Relations with Former Nazi Criminals". The focus of the article is the eight million pages of documents recently released which deal with German and Japanese war crimes during World War II. The documents demonstrate that the US often overlooked or even protected known Nazi war criminals, merely because said criminals were or could be of use to the US. States the article, "The price one pays for consorting with evil men far outweighs the return."

Considering your bureau's apparent preoccupation with Jews and firearms, and the historical indifference the US paid to Nazi war criminals during and after WWII, I believe millions of gunowners would be very interested to know whether you personally are aware of the Nazi origins of "gun control," and when -- or if -- the FBI has done any investigations into the racism and bigotry reflected in our current firearms laws. If not, why not?

The second reason for this letter is the Congressional Research Service's report on the lack of standardized testing procedures and policies in the BATFE's firearms division (see <http://www.jpfo.org/ATFguntests.pdf>). The BATFE has sent hundreds -- if not thousands -- of gunowners to prison for "firearms violations" ... yet the CRS report clearly indicates that the decisions on whether a firearm is legal or illegal is arbitrary and spurious at best.

Don't believe me? In our DVD entitled "BATFE Fails the Test" (<http://www.jpfo.org/batfevideo.htm>), you can watch as a self-proclaimed BATFE firearms "expert" attempts to force a semi-automatic rifle to rapid-fire (and thus "prove" the rifle is an illegal machine gun). Fortunately for the BATFE's victim, a \_real\_ expert demonstrates that the rifle was malfunctioning, and the case was eventually dismissed.

Not everyone is so lucky, as tests are seldom videotaped and the sentencing judge is left with the BATFE's word against the accused. Unsurprisingly, the BATFE's statements are usually given greater credence. (Please contact us if you would like a copy of the DVD for your research).

## MEXICO HWY ?

Bush sneaking North American super-state without oversight? Mexico, Canada partnership underway with no authorization from Congress

The SPP report to the heads of state of the U.S., Mexico and Canada, -- released June 27, 2005, -- lists some 20 different working groups spanning a wide variety of issues ranging from e-commerce, to aviation policy, to borders and immigration, involving the activity of multiple U.S. government agencies.

The working groups have produced a number of memorandums of understanding and trilateral declarations of agreement. MAKAAALA !!!

## What Makes You an American?

And what kind of country will we have when we're surrounded by one huge "Berlin Wall"?

Walls aren't the answer. But neither, ultimately, are guest worker programs or any other political proposals. America is for American Citizens and our invited guests.

Illegal immigration is dangerous to this country because so many of the people flooding in don't understand what being an American is. They come from corrupt, oppressive, over-governed countries. They want better lives. Many come here looking for material wealth. Yet they don't understand that material wealth is only a bi-product of freedom. YES.....FREEDOM ! from oppressive government.

Many come here looking for opportunity. But they don't understand that opportunity is also a bi-product of freedom.

Others come here looking for a free ride (for themselves or their children) on America's vast and growing train of "free" social services. But they don't understand that all those "free" government programs are destroying freedom -- and ultimately will destroy even the prosperity they seek.

Freedom is what makes America different from all other countries. Individual liberty, individual responsibility, a shared language and individual initiative have made Americans an awesome force for more than 200 years. Millions of the illegals pouring across our borders don't understand that.

They come from countries where only corrupt politicians and their agents are "allowed" to use firearms. So they think it's natural for ordinary people to be disarmed and helpless.

An American is flesh and bone. But so are all other people. An American is also an idea in action. The idea of individual freedom. Everyone who shares that ideal enhances America. Everyone who fails to cherish that idea fails our nation.





**New Book Release:**

**Gaijin Yokozuna : A Biography of Chad Rowan**

*Yokozuna* is the highest ranking *sumotori* (one who does sumo). *GAIJIN*



*YOKOZUNA: A Biography of Chad Rowan* is the story of the first *gaijin* (non-Japanese) to advance to sumo's top rank, attaining the title at the age of 23. At the age of eighteen, a graduate of Kaiser High School in Honolulu after a semester at Hawaii Pacific University, Chad Rowan of Waimanalo was recruited into Azumazeki-Beya the stable of Maui-born Takamiyama.

Author Mark Panek teaches English at the University of Hawaii, Hilo became interested in sumo in 1992, when an increasing number of foreign athletes began attaining high ranks in the ancient Japanese sport. Panek returned to Japan in 1998 to follow the Japan Sumo Association exhibition tours, attended major tournaments and daily practices and interview Chad Rowan, his mother Janice Rowan and his brothers Ola and Nunu, other *sumotori* including close friends George Kalima and the late Percy

Kipapa.

*GAIJIN YOKOZUNA*, traces Hawaiian Chad Rowan's journey to be the personification of "Japanese" at the 1998 Nagano Olympics when he performed a sacred sumo ritual at the opening of the ceremony, after becoming yokozuna and eventually retiring from sumo.

On his journey to becoming the 64th *Yokozuna* in history of Sumo, Rowan endures the transitions to a culture, language, way of life and internalizes Japanese concepts of *gaman* (even injured, "tape it up, suck it up and go"), *shikata ga nai* ("no can help" that's the way it is), *hinkaku*, a special kind of dignity thought to be available only to Japanese-- and more. At 6'8" and eventually 500#, the tall *sumotori* learned to use his mind and body to be awarded the great white rope with five zigzag white paper fastened to the front of the heavy rope -- around Akebono's massive waist -- in January, 1993. Author Panek tells a riveting story of sumo, the intricate ceremony, social, historical, and *sumobeya* relationships as lived by Akebono and others. *GAIJIN YOKOZUNA* is the story of growing up in Waimanalo for the Rowan sons and what leads one to become known world-wide as Yokozuna Akebono.

The story briefly examines the careers of two Hawaii-born *sumotori* who paved the way for Rowan -- Jesse Kuhaulua (Takamiyama) and Salevaa Atisanoe (Konishiki). Fans of sumo, athletics, and Japanese culture will enjoy this story of *GAIJIN YOKOZUNA*.
