

YOUNG BROTHERS FUEL CHARGE

Fuel Price Increases Nearly 44 Percent Since March 2008

Young Brothers, Limited will nearly double its Fuel Price Adjustment (FPA) to 4.22 percent from 2.78 percent, as of June 3, 2008. The increase was initiated in response to fuel prices that have risen almost 44 percent since Young Brothers' last fuel adjustment in March 2008.

"Three months ago, diesel was at \$2.90 a gallon; now it's at \$4.17. The rapid spike in fuel prices is driving the Fuel Price Adjustment; however, because the adjustment reflects the average fuel costs for the previous three-month period, it does not reflect the current cost of fuel," said Roy Catalani, vice president for Young Brothers government relations. "In response to escalating fuel prices, we are continuing to streamline and improve our equipment and our operations. One example is that our new barges designed to carry more freight without increasing the tug's fuel consumption."

North Pole Fishing/Oil Resources Are looming Conflict with Russia & Canada

SECRETARY RICE URGED TO DEFEND RIGHTS OF AMERICANS to the open ocean and seabeds AGAINST takeover of the North Pole by Russia, Canada, Norway, and Denmark during the Arctic summit in Greenland last week May 27. This action "...threatens the rights of Americans to the open ocean and seabeds," stated Carl Olson, chairman of State Department Watch, a foreign policy watchdog group.

The four countries are asserting sovereign rights to the North Pole ocean area and seabeds under the Law of the Sea Treaty (LOST). The United States is not a party to LOST. Its position is that the ocean should remain open to all persons and companies of all countries for peaceful use.

LOST would allow countries to take over oceans and seabeds beyond the already existing 200-nautical mile Exclusive Economic Zones under the theory of underwater outercontinental shelf extensions. It would impose a U.N. regime involving a Seabed Authority/Enterprise that can tax the users.

Russia is claiming the North Pole area on such a LOST theory. However, it is flawed due to the fact that its claim runs right through five American Arctic islands. These are Wrangell, Herald, Bennett, Jeannette, and Henrietta. The latter three are in the DeLong Islands, named for the United States Navy ship captain George Washington DeLong whose expedition discovered them in 1881.

Canada has been so antagonistic to the U. S. over EEZ affairs such that no maritime boundaries between the mutual EEZs have been agreed upon either in the Arctic, Pacific, or Atlantic. In contrast, the U. S. has had maritime agreements with Mexico, Russia, Cuba, and Venezuela for decades. The situation around Alaska has been so acute that the Alaska Legislature in 1999 passed House Joint Resolution 26, sponsored by Representative John Coghill Jr., to urge the State Department to negotiate maritime boundaries immediately. The State Department ignored it.

An attempted takeover of much of the Arctic Ocean was asserted by Russia in 1906 under a "sector theory" such that all countries bordering on the Arctic Ocean would be given sovereign rights over the entire Arctic Ocean between those land areas and the North Pole. The U.S. rejected this claim outright.

The Arctic Ocean should remain a free and open ocean for all peoples and not under the closure by the United Nations, The public and the Congress have every reason to be wary.

Next, the President will give away Hawaii to Russia or China ?—MAN





This week's outrage comes to us from Winchendon, Massachusetts where, in yet another case of "zero-tolerance" enforcement defying common sense, fourth-grader Bradley Geslak was suspended from Toy Town Elementary School for bringing a Memorial Day souvenir to school.

According to a May 29, Telegram.com article, a uniformed veteran gave the 10-year-old two empty rifle shell casings from blanks used during the town's Memorial Day celebration Monday morning. Bradley gave one of the empty casings to his grandfather and kept the other as a souvenir. The trouble began when he took his souvenir to school the next day.

"He was just playing with it at lunch," explained Crystal Geslak, Bradley's mother. "He wasn't showing it to anyone; he had it in his hand and was playing with it."

A teacher saw him with the harmless piece of brass and confiscated it. Ms. Geslak was then called at work and told to come and pick up her son, who had been suspended for five days!

Ms. Geslak arrived at the school to find her son in tears. "I was totally shocked. I couldn't believe this was happening," she said. "It was just an empty shell, not even from a real bullet. A sharpened pencil would be more dangerous than this piece of metal."

"He was so proud to have been given them. His dad's a veteran, his uncle's a veteran, both his grandfathers are veterans. Memorial Day is a big thing to us. It's a very important holiday and we have a big celebration every year," Ms. Geslak said.

Ms. Geslak, who will be forced to miss work in order to stay home with her son, says she is worried about what having a "weapon-related suspension" on his school record will mean to his future.

To add insult to injury, the family says a school official told them that the shell would not be returned, and that the next step might involve assigning a probation officer to Bradley! Yes, you read that right, a probation officer.

A young boy punished over a harmless souvenir. By any standard, that's outrageous.

The goal of the founders of America was to restrict government within severe limits and to protect the rights of sovereign individuals. Government has NO rights!






