



Criminal Charges Filed Against Former Pres. Bush in Iceland

Reykjavik, Iceland- A group of ten Icelandic citizens filed July 3 at the Office of the State's Police Chief criminal charges against George H.W. Bush, former U.S. President, who was expected in Iceland that evening at the invitation of Iceland's President Olafur R. Grimsson.

The group accuses former President Bush for participation in war crimes, crimes against humanity, crimes against the peace, and crimes against internationally protected persons. It demands that former President Bush be detained by the Icelandic authorities and investigation on these charges.

Should the investigation conclude that legal proceedings against him are warranted, the group requests that he be tried before an Icelandic court. Icelandic courts are, under international law, qualified to try individuals suspected of having committed international crimes.

George H.W. Bush is charged for initiating a war of aggression against Panama in 1989, in breach of international law and the UN Charter, constituting a crime against the peace, and of ordering the kidnapping of Panama's President Noriega in violation of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes Against Internationally Protected Persons. George H.W. Bush is furthermore charged for his command responsibility for the multiple war crimes committed by US forces in the Gulf War in 1991, including the policy of deliberately bombing civilian targets and the massacre of soldiers not involved in combat. His command responsibility for these crimes is equivalent to those of other heads of states who have been charged, indicted and convicted for international crimes, including torture, war crimes, crimes against humanity and genocide. George H.W. Bush is also charged for inducing an uprising of Kurds and Shi'ites in Iraq during the Gulf War and then ordering US forces to withhold military support from those who risked the uprising, thus leaving unarmed uprising masses unprotected against Saddam Hussein's brutal forces. By such policies, he knowingly facilitated the commission of crimes against humanity by Saddam Hussein. He is finally accused for conspiring to impose deadly economic sanctions against the people of Iraq, with the intent to harm the well-being, health and lives of the Iraqi civilian population, with foreknowledge of the likely consequences and with the subsequent knowledge of the sanctions' devastating consequences. Such conduct is considered to be a crime against humanity under international customary law. About one million persons are believed dead as a result of the economic sanctions, and half a million children below five years of age.

The group holds that Icelandic courts can assert subject-matter, territorial and personal jurisdiction over former President Bush, pursuant to the provisions of the Geneva Conventions of 12 August 1949 and of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes Against Internationally Protected Persons.

U.S. Soldiers Charged in Rape and Murder-Coverup in Iraq

Col. Jeffrey Snow, a US brigade commander in Baghdad, told AFP News that news coverage could cause the US to lose the war. In other words, what we are doing in Iraq cannot stand the light of day, so news reporters must not report or the word will get out, therefore the truth of the Iraq war must be suppressed.

The soldiers, coverup attempt also involved the murder of other members of the murdered rape victim's family, including a child.

Many Americans are so unsophisticated that they refuse to believe anything bad about the way their country and military is being led. They regard acceptance of unpalatable truths as disloyalty. This failure of American character is why Bush has been able to get away with transgressions that scream out for his impeachment and trial as a war criminal. The premeditated rape and murders are just the latest in the long line of horrific war crimes from Abu Ghraib to Haditha, back to Afghanistan and GITMO, and 9-11-01. Bush supporters are still in denial about each incident.

To this day the Bush regime and the neocon nazis have NOT told us the reason for their invasion of Iraq, the destruction of its towns and infrastructure, and the slaughter of its citizens. Every reason Bush has given has proved to be a lie. There is no more reason for US troops to be shooting up Iraq than to be shooting up Canada, Scotland, Holland, Spain, Taiwan, Florida, Virginia or California. U.S. is killing Iraqis for no reason but that they resist U.S. invasion and occupation of their country.

So far, the American public and its elected representatives in Congress refuse to rein in the Bush regime and to hold them responsible for these monstrous crimes. America has become a land of evil, in the eyes of the rest of the world. And we are going to pay a terrible price for it. Pres. Bush's belief that U.S. superpower status makes us immune to reality goes beyond hubris into insanity.


Co-workers, parents and children wish Auntie Norma a happy, healthy, active, not too busy retirement! Thank you for all your years of service to children and their families.

GMO foods may produce herbicide inside Human intestines

Pioneer Hi-Bred's website boasts that their genetically modified (GM) Liberty Link corn survives doses of herbicide, which would normally kill corn. The reason, they say, is that the herbicide becomes "inactive in the corn plant." They fail to reveal, however, that after you eat the GM corn, some inactive herbicide may become reactivated inside your gut and cause a toxic reaction. In addition, a gene that was inserted into the corn might transfer into the DNA of your gut bacteria, producing long-term effects. These are just a couple of the many potential side-effects of GM crops that critics say put the public at risk.

Herbicide tolerance (HT) is one of two basic traits common to nearly all GM crops. About 71% of the crops are engineered to resist herbicide, including Liberty (glufosinate ammonium) and Roundup (glyphosate). About 18% produce their own pesticide. And 11% do both. The four major GM crops are soy, corn, cotton and canola, all of which have approved Roundup-tolerant varieties. Herbicide tolerant (HT) crops are a particularly big money-maker for biotech companies, because when farmers buy HT seeds, they are required to purchase the companies' brand of herbicide as well. In addition, HT crops dramatically increase the use of herbicide, which further contributes to the companies' bottom line.

There are no required safety tests for HT crops in the US-if the biotech companies declare them fit for human consumption, the FDA has no further questions. But many scientists and consumers remain concerned, and some varieties pose unique risks.

Herbicides (marketed as Roundup, Basta, Ignite, Rely, Finale and Challenge) can kill a wide variety of plants. It can also kill bacteria, fungi and insects, and has toxic effects on humans and animals. The herbicide is derived from a natural antibiotic, which is produced by two strains of a soil bacterium. In order that the bacteria are not killed by the antibiotic that they themselves create, the strains also produce specialized enzymes which transform the antibiotic to a non-toxic form called NAG (N-acetyl-L-glufosinate). The specialized enzymes are called the pat protein and the bar protein, which are produced by the pat gene and the bar gene, respectively. The two genes are inserted into the DNA of GM crops, where they produce the enzymes in every cell. When the plant is sprayed, the herbicide's solvents and surfactants transport glufosinate ammonium throughout the plant, where the enzymes convert it primarily into NAG. Thus, the GM plant detoxifies the herbicide and lives, while surrounding weeds die.

The problem is that the NAG, which is not naturally present in plants, remains there and accumulates with every subsequent spray. Thus, when we eat these GM crops, we consume NAG. Once the NAG is inside our digestive system, some of it may be re-transformed back into the toxic herbicide. In rats fed NAG, for example, 10% of it was converted back to glufosinate by the time it was excreted in the feces. Another rat study found a 1% conversion. And with goats, more than one-third of what was excreted had turned into glufosinate.

It is believed that gut bacteria, primarily found in the colon or rectum, are responsible for this re-toxicification. Although these parts of the gut do not absorb as many nutrients as other sections, rats fed NAG did show toxic effects. This indicates that the herbicide had been regenerated, was biologically active, and had been assimilated by the rats. A goat study also confirmed that some of the herbicide regenerated from NAG ended up in the kidneys, liver, muscle, fat and milk.

More information about the impact of this conversion is presumably found in "Toxicology and Metabolism Studies" on NAG, submitted to European regulators by AgrEvo (now Bayer CropScience). These unpublished studies were part of the application seeking approval of herbicide-tolerant canola. When the UK government's Pesticide Safety Directorate attempted to provide some of this information to an independent researcher, they were blocked by the company's threats of legal action. The studies remained private.

Toxicity of the herbicide Glufosinate ammonium is structurally similar to a natural amino acid called glutamic acid, which can stimulate the central nervous system and, in excess levels, cause the death of nerve cells in the brain. The common reactions to glufosinate poisoning in humans include unconsciousness, respiratory distress and convulsions. One study also linked the herbicide with a kidney disorder. These reactions typically involve large amounts of the herbicide. It is unclear if the amount converted from GM crops would accumulate to promote such responses or if there are low dose chronic effects.

Perhaps a more critical question may be whether infants or fetuses are impacted with smaller doses. A January 2006 report issued by the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Office of Inspector General said that studies demonstrate that certain pesticides easily enter the brain of young children and fetuses, and can destroy cells.

Research has nonetheless accumulated which suggests that glufosinate carries significant risks for the next generation. According to Yoichiro Kuroda, the principal investigator in the Japanese project entitled "Effects of Endocrine Disrupters on the Developing Brain," glufosinate is like a "mock neurotransmitter." Exposure of a baby or embryo can affect behavior, because the chemical disturbs gene functions that regulate brain development.

When mouse embryos were exposed to glufosinate, it resulted in growth retardation, increased death rates, incomplete development of the forebrain and cleft lips, as well as cell death in part of the brain. After pregnant rats were injected with glufosinate, the number of glutamate receptors in the brains of the offspring appeared to be reduced. When infant rats were exposed to low doses of glufosinate, some of their brain receptors appeared to change as well.

Glufosinate herbicide might also influence behavior. According to Kuroda, "female rats born from mothers that were given high doses of glufosinate became aggressive and started to bite each other-in some cases until one died." He added, "That report sent a chill through me."

If the herbicide is regenerated inside our gut, since it is an antibiotic, it will likely kill gut bacteria. Gut microorganisms are crucial for health. They not only provide essential metabolites like certain vitamins and short fatty acids, but also help the break down and absorption of food and protect against pathogens. Disrupting the balance of gut bacteria can cause a wide range of problems. According to molecular geneticist Ricarda Steinbrecher, "the data obtained strongly suggest that the balance of gut bacteria will be affected" by the conversion of NAG to glufosinate.

Supreme Court's decision in Hamdan vs. Rumsfeld could expose officials to prosecution

THE U.S. SUPREME Court on June 29 dealt the Bush administration a stinging rebuke, declaring in Hamdan vs. Rumsfeld that military commissions for trying terrorist suspects violate both U.S. military law and the Geneva Convention.

But the real blockbuster in the Hamdan decision is the court's holding that Common Article 3 of the Geneva Convention applies to the conflict with Al Qaeda ~ a holding that makes high-ranking Bush administration officials potentially subject to prosecution under the federal War Crimes Act, because the provisions of the Geneva Convention were intended to protect noncombatants ~ including prisoners ~ in times of armed conflict.

But as the Bush administration has repeatedly noted, most of these protections apply only to conflicts between states. Because Al Qaeda is not a state, the administration argued that the Geneva Convention didn't apply to the war on terror. These assertions gave the administration's arguments a fuzzy quality. On the one hand, the administration argued that the struggle against terrorism was a war, subject only to the law of war, not U.S. criminal or constitutional law. On the other hand, the administration said the Geneva Convention didn't apply to the war with Al Qaeda, which put the war on terror in an anything-goes legal limbo.

This novel theory served as the administration's legal cover for a wide range of questionable tactics, ranging from the Guantanamo military tribunals to administration efforts to hold even U.S. citizens indefinitely without counsel, charge or trial. Perhaps most troubling, it allowed the administration to claim that detained terrorism suspects could be subjected to interrogation techniques that constitute torture or cruel, inhuman and degrading treatment under international law, such as "waterboarding," placing prisoners in painful physical positions, sexual humiliation and extreme sleep deprivation. Under Bush logic, these tactics were not illegal under U.S. law because U.S. law was trumped by the law of war, and they weren't illegal under the law of war either, because Geneva Convention prohibitions on torture and cruel treatment were not applicable to the conflict with Al Qaeda.


In 2005, Congress angered President Bush by passing Sen. John McCain's amendment explicitly prohibiting the use of cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment of detainees. But Congress did not attach criminal penalties to violations of the amendment, and the administration has repeatedly indicated its intent to ignore it.

The Hamdan decision may change a few minds within the administration. Although the decision's practical effect on the military tribunals is unclear ~ the administration may be able to gain explicit congressional authorization for the tribunals, or it may be able to modify them to comply with the laws of war ~ the court's declaration that Common Article 3 applies to the war on terror is of enormous significance. Ultimately, it could pave the way for war crimes prosecutions of those responsible for abusing detainees, up the chain of command even to President.

Common Article 3 forbids "cruel treatment and torture [and] outrages upon personal dignity, in particular humiliating and degrading treatment." The provision's language is sweeping enough to prohibit many of the interrogation techniques approved by the Bush administration. That's why the administration had argued that Common Article 3 did not apply to the war on terror, even though legal experts have long concluded that it was intended to provide minimum rights guarantees for all conflicts not otherwise covered by the Geneva Convention.

But here's where the rubber really hits the road. Under federal criminal law, anyone who "commits a war crime shall be fined or imprisoned for life or any term of years, or both, and if death results to the victim, shall also be subject to the penalty of death." And a war crime is defined as "any conduct which constitutes a violation of Common Article 3 of the international conventions signed at Geneva." In other words, with the Hamdan decision, U.S. officials found to be responsible for subjecting war on terror detainees to torture, cruel treatment or other "outrages upon personal dignity" could face prison or even the death penalty.

Don't expect that to happen anytime soon, of course. For prosecutions to occur, some federal prosecutor would have to issue an indictment. And in the Justice Department of Atty. Gen. Alberto Gonzales ~ who famously called the Geneva Convention "quaint", and rationalized the illegal surveillance of U.S. Citizens, I think that a genuine investigation into the Bush administration's violations of the War Crimes Act just won't happen as long as the Patients run the asylum. Redux 1984 ?



New Book Release: *Leaving Paradise: Indigenous Hawaiians in the Pacific Northwest 1787-1898*

authors Jean Barman & Bruce McIntyre Watson



Kanaka maoli have migrated to the Pacific Northwest since the 1700s! In recent years, many have ventured to Washington State and Oregon areas for education and economic opportunities. The new book, published by the University of Hawai'i Press tells the story of some who chose to seek job opportunities in the fur and fishing trade. Although some settlements such as Salt Spring Island, Fort Nisqually and Fort Vancouver have documented names, dates, jobs accomplished, the stories of these extraordinary individuals have gone largely unrecorded. Authors Jean Barman and Bruce Watson through painstaking archival work in British Columbia, Oregon, California and Hawaii, have woven a history of what is known about these early sailors, laborers and settlers from 1787 to 1898. Much of the book includes descriptive biographical entries on

some eight hundred Native Hawaiians.

This is a valuable resource for the "Kanakas" as they were called, who formed settlements throughout the Pacific Northwest with indigenous wives, raising families in the harsh conditions and racial challenges of the late 1700s through the 1800s. More recently, some of the families have revived interest in Hawaiian traditions with visits to Hawaii. The Nahane clan of the Squamish Nation have hosted groups of indigenous Hawaiians including outrigger teams. That family established a competitive outrigger canoe club that represents the Squamish nation in international events. According to *LEAVING PARADISE*, the Kalamas of Washington State have sustained contact with Kalama's living on Moloka'i. The ties between indigenous people of Hawai'i and the Pacific Northwest continue. This is a historical document of what life must have been like for the pioneers on land and sea. Contributions of native Hawaiians extend beyond the seafaring and fur trade. Through hard work and persistence, the earliest voyagers have left meaningful impact on their home away from "paradise."



The cops stepped back, then said it will be better for me to come out now.

I said I don't think so. You are not being upfront with me. What do you want to say to me? What will you do if I do not come out?

The cops repeated its better you come out now. Are you afraid of us?

I said yes, I am afraid of you, acting suspicious. And this sounds like a threat to my safety, so you folks must leave now, and I walked away from the gate.

The two cops then yelled, ok, we will see you on the road. [another threat to me].

I finally got Sgt. Meyer on the phone and he told me they had an arrest warrant for me signed by judge Ige regarding cases in 1999 [malicious prosecution cases were removed to United States Court], and Ige says Contempt of Court Failure to Appear on January 10, 2006 in Molokai District Court. Sounds like Ruby Ridge redux! Of course I had NO notice from this Molokai Chancery to appear, so now they want to kidnapp me and extort \$200 to secure my release. Sgt. Meyer said I can turn myself in and pay the \$200, or if cops see me driving on the road, they will do a traffic stop and arrest me, take me into custody. He said they had a warrant but chose not to raid my home.

This is police state retaliation for my supporting Kaapuni in his case [Kaapuni v. Carlton Helm] against the police for their breaking glass door and entering his home No Knock Raid, and no affidavit, no valid warrant, property damaged, no drugs found, guns in their faces, illegal arrests, take \$7000 cash grandmothers, no inventory list, etc etc.... major 4th Am violations by cops. I need an Order for Injunctive relief from RICO.

COMES NOW, George Peabody, United States National Citizen Sui Juris in Proper Party representative of the United States of America and real party to the action who appears for the Court under 28 U.S.C. § 1654 swears, affirms and verifies as proved in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1746 the following NOTICE OF INJUNCTION, MEMORANDUM BRIEF OF LAW, VERIFICATION, OATH OF OFFICE AND NOTICE OF SERVICE for the following cause of action:

1. George Peabody is informed and aware of a criminal conspiracy by the respondents in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2331 (Patriot Act) to commit acts of domestic terrorism against his person internationally protected in accordance with 18 U.S.C. § 112 pertaining to representatives of the United States of America inhabiting the constituent state of Hawaii.

2. George Peabody is informed and aware of a criminal conspiracy by the respondents in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 241 and 18 U.S.C. § 242 to kidnap his person and to hold him to ransom against the law of the United States of America at 18 U.S.C. § 1202.

3. George Peabody is informed and aware of a criminal conspiracy by the respondents in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1512 to obstruct justice and to retaliate against a witness as defined at 18 U.S.C. § 1513.

4. George Peabody states affirmatively that this court has jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1651 to order immediate injunction against the respondent parties under the laws of the United States of America and that this civil action has priority in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1657 to acknowledge the right of injunctive relief in issue of this preliminary injunction under Procedural Rule 65.

MEMORANDUM BRIEF OF LAW

The facts of the case for INJUNCTION are that George Peabody has removed a case to the United States Court for the District of Hawaii. Twenty days have passed and the defendant respondents have neither refuted the facts nor demanded jury trial for bill in equity. Supreme Court Blocks Bush, Gitmo War Trials

Jun 29 The Supreme Court ruled Thursday that President Bush overstepped his authority in ordering military war crimes trials for Guantanamo Bay detainees.

The ruling, a rebuke to the administration and its aggressive anti-terror policies, was written by Justice John Paul Stevens, who said the proposed trials were illegal under U.S. law and international Geneva conventions.

Two years ago, the court rejected Bush's claim to have the authority to seize and detain terrorism suspects and indefinitely deny them access to courts or lawyers. In this follow-up case, the justices focused solely on the issue of trials.

The vote was split 5-3, with moderate Justice Anthony M. Kennedy joining the court's liberal members in ruling against the Bush administration. Chief Justice John Roberts, named to the lead the court last September by Bush, was sidelined in the case because as an appeals court judge he had backed the government over Hamdan

Thursday's ruling overturned that decision.

Supreme Court's landmark ruling in the Hamdan v. Rumsfeld case was the establishment by the court majority that all Bush administration claims to the contrary, the Geneva Convention rules regarding captured prisoners apply to the captives taken not only in the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan, but in the so-called War on Terror.

What has been largely missed is the clear point that the Supreme Court has thus now declared that for the past five years, Bush and his gang of war-mongers, including Vice President Dick Cheney, Secretary of Defense Donald Rumsfeld, Secretary of State and former National Security Adviser Condoleezza Rice, former Attorney General Donald Rumsfeld and current Attorney General and former White House Chief Counsel Alberto Gonzales, and many others in the administration, have been guilty of violating the Third Convention on treatment of prisoners of war. They are also, therefore, in violation of federal law, which back in 1996 adopted that convention as part of the U.S. criminal code.

In other words, the whole top administration, from Commander in Chief George W. Bush on down, is guilty of war crimes. The punishment for committing war crimes ranges from a lengthy jail sentence to, in the event the crimes in question caused the death of any prisoners being held, to death. And there have been many deaths among those who have been held and tortured on orders of the administration--most recently the three suicides at Guantanamo, which included on man who had only three days earlier been targeted for release (but who never learned this because government's secrecy and tight security prevented his attorneys at the Center for Constitutional Rights from getting the news to him).

Interestingly, Gonzales actually cautioned Bush about this possibility. In a memo to the president, written on January 25, 2002 when he was still White House counsel, Gonzales warned prophetically that the U.S. adoption of the Third Geneva Convention as a part of the U.S. criminal code in 1996 made violation of the convention a "war crime" under U.S. law, which he said was defined as "any grave breach" of the Third Convention such as "outrages against personal dignity." He noted that this law applied whether or not a detained person qualified for POW status, and added that punishment for violation of the law "include the death penalty." But then he went on to say Bush could "substantially reduce" his risk of domestic criminal prosecution under the War Crimes Act by making a presidential determination that the Third Geneva Convention "does not apply to al Qaeda and the Taliban."


In Bush's case, this crime calls for his impeachment, and for his subsequent prosecution as a war criminal. In the case of his subordinates and abettors, it calls for criminal indictments.

Naturally, we cannot expect to see indictments issue from the Attorney General's Office, particularly given Gonzales' own complicity and personal culpability on the war crimes charge. Conceivably, I suppose, some career prosecutor like Patrick Fitzgerald, who has been given wide authority in his special counsel role, could bring charges, though this seems highly unlikely. Charges could also be brought by another country whose laws permit such extraterritoriality: Germany or Spain for example, or Iceland who has already indicted former Pres. Bush Sr. for war crimes.

Meanwhile, we who value America's once elevated standing in the world as a supporter and author of the Geneva Conventions, should begin a campaign to press the Congress to consider a bill of impeachment against Bush for war crimes.

The deliberate policy of involving the military in the commission of war crimes--torture, kidnapping, denial of access to some process of challenge the justice of their detention--is among the worst of all of those crimes against the Constitution.

The blood of war crime victims is on Bush's hands, and the hands of his henchmen, but unless we the people act, and unless the Congress acts, to call them to account, it will ultimately be on all of our hands.



