## 2008 Molokai Obon Festival

The Guzeiji Soto Mission of Molokai hosted the annual Bon Festival, welcoming home the spirits of the departed. The two-day observance began with memorial services at the Kapaakea Cemetery. The afternoon and evening Guzeiji Soto Mission in Mango Lane were conducted by visiting Rev. Roy Ryosho Kokuzo from Waipahu Soto Sen Temple Taiyoji.

On Saturday morning Bon Dance practice was led by bon odori teacher Helen Kishi and a Taiko workshop conducted by Helen Faye Komagata were open to the public.

Saturday evening the Rev. Kokuzo led a brief service to open the Bon Dance. Somei Taiko, Aiea Taiko and Hawaii Matsuri Taiko members brought the popular Taiko performances to the yagura (tower) inviting the Molokai community to follow some of the familiar bon dances and enjoy some of the modern beats. Inside the Mitchell Pauole Center Hall, members of Soto Mission set up cultural exhibits and the Japanese Cultural Center of Hawaii (JCCH) brought their outreach program of make and take crafts for young and young at heart. Using stamps and a fabric strip, hachimaki (headbands) was a popular activity. Gyotaku, fishprinting with JCCH volunteer director Derek Iwata was a hit with Molokai youngsters. Mrs. Ryusetsu Kokuzo demonstrated sumi-e (brush painting) and helped keiki write their names in kanji (shodo).

Through the Guzeiji Soto Mission's exhibits, the Japanese values and the Ganen Mono first immigrants brought to Hawaii beginning in 1868 - those following learn and honor our ancestors through "Okage Sama De" ("I am what I am because of you.")

MOA of Maui's Normal Oshiro brought buckets of carnations for everyone to make a miniature flower arrangement. Creating paradise through flowers, according to the teaching MOA founder Mokichi Okada.

If you missed this year's observance, remember, the summer months, July through August is Bon Festival and on Molokai, it's usually chicken hekka, taiko, bon odori and time for family reunions. The colorful festival takes place around the islands, celebrating families, tradition and life.




## Federal Marijuana Decriminalization?

A federal marijuana decriminalization bill to Remove Federal Penalties for the Personal Use of Marijuana by Responsible Adults has been introduced to Congress. "The federal government should stop arresting marijuana users,"

Frank said as he stood before Congress.

20 million Americans have been arrested on marijuana charges, 830,000 in 2006 (<http://www.fbi.gov/ucr/cius2006/index.html>). Of those, nearly 90% were for simple possession. In addition to the jail time and other costs imposed on offenders, marijuana law enforcement costs society more than \$7 billion a year. Existing laws aimed at marijuana users punish otherwise law-abiding citizens and sick people whose doctors have recommended the drug, and waste law enforcement resources, Frank said. They also amount to an unwarranted intrusion into the private lives of Americans, he said.

Here is the text of the bill in its entirety:

"Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no penalty may be imposed under an Act of Congress for the possession of marijuana for personal use, or for the not-for-profit transfer between adults of marijuana for personal use. For the purposes of this section, possession of 100 grams or less of marijuana shall be presumed to be for personal use, as shall the not-for-profit transfer of one ounce or less of marijuana, except that the civil penalty provided in section 405 of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 844a) may be imposed for the public use of marijuana if the amount of the penalty does not exceed \$100."

There is absolutely nothing wrong with the responsible use of marijuana by adults and this should be of no interest or concern to the government. The vast majority of marijuana smokers are adults who cause no harm to themselves or to anyone else, so there is no reason for the state or feds to be involved, except to make efforts to stop irresponsible use. Responsible alcohol drinkers are not arrested. That should be our policy with marijuana as well, but, there were more than 11 million marijuana arrests since 1990, that's more than for "all violent crimes combined. Marijuana prohibition is "one of the most destructive criminal justice policies in America.
