

George Peabody files Nomination Papers for Office of governor

Obon Celebration Features Hawaii Matsuri Taiko

Obon is the Buddhist celebration of the return of ancestors' spirits. On July 15th, the Molokai Guzeji Soto Mission again hosted the summer religious celebration of life and remembered especially those who have passed on in the last year.

Rev. Shuji Komagata from the Aiea Soto Mission led the celebration with a brief service. Earlier, the thundering taiko of the Hawaii Matsuri Taiko led by Sensei Komagata called the community to participate in the annual celebration.

Kodomo (keiki) and other interested were invited from the audience to sample a basic lesson and experience the thrill of taiko.

Hawaii Matsuri Taiko and members from Wahiawa Soto Mission accompanied by Sensei Komagata have trekked to Molokai to share the joy of taiko for more than twenty

years. For the past several months, Molokai residents have had the opportunity to learn taiko and performed with Hawaii Matsuri Taiko. Classes are held at the Soto Mission on Thursday evenings, 6:45pm.

Obon came with sugar and pineapple immigrants from Japan who brought their Buddhist beliefs and practice, over a hundred years ago. Now, everyone participates and dances for their ancestors and for the joy of the folk dances. The young people of Hawaii Matsuri Taiko also bring their skills of song, playing flute and chimes as well. For many Molokai families, obon is a time for reunion and return to their roots.

Molokai Ranch, Dispatch & Island Times, Councilman Danny Mateo, Linda Lingle are pushing the Taxpayer Subsidizing of Private Development in Kaluakoi and Maunaloa

Taxpayers should not be scammed into paying for real property improvements to benefit Molokai Ranch's object of maximum real estate sales and development in Kaluakoi and Maunaloa. But, it's been going on a long time: back when MR got millions of tax credit funding to tear down Maunaloa and build taxpayer subsidized rental housing; a flurry of more development by MR of their commercial complexes, theatre, fast food, adopting The Dispatch to spread their propaganda, talk about making Maunaloa the major town of Molokai drawing businesses from Kaunakakai etc, Linda Lingle giving MR \$500,000 taxpayer dollars to build community center and swimming pool, and MR always demanding more money from Taxpayers to fund their dreams of massive development in West Molokai. It's got to be stopped soon or the westend of Molokai will soon be careening in an irreversible real estate boom for 30,000 wealthy people filling Laau Point to Kaluakoi Hotel and Maunaloa Town with their homes and demands for county and state services, and lots of water. The negative political and economic impacts on Molokai's people, culture and lifestyle, natural resources, and the cost of living from 30,000 new people is obvious, undeniable, and undesirable to most local residents who love Molokai as it is and who are not dependent on Molokai Ranch's efforts to dominate sovereign individuals.

As Peter Nicholas now, and those Molokai Ranch agents before him, skillfully manipulate the county and State and federal grant money-tax-credit-government funding program scams that ripoff Taxpayers, and their sycophant editors at Dispatch and Times spin the truth into frivolous distractions, and quisling politicians like Mateo and Lingle lure the people with empty unaccountable political rhetoric, Molokai residents can be sure that if they do not stand together against these conspirators and stop corporate welfare to MR, stop water ripoff to benefit MR's development dreams, they will soon be a small minority in a democracy.

GUN RIGHTS LAW in EMERGENCY

Bad news: Sen. Dan Akaka, & Sen. Dan Inouye Oppose Gun Rights!

Good news! The Senate voted 84-16 to pass the pro-gun Vitter amendment.

July 13, 2006, all 55 Republicans, joined by 28 Democrats and 1 Independent, voted to pass Senator David Vitter's (R-La.) amendment to prohibit the use of taxpayer funds allocated under the Homeland Security appropriations bill (H.R. 5441) to be used to confiscate lawfully-possessed firearms during an emergency or major disaster. Sixteen Senators opposed the prohibition.

In passing this legislation, the United States Senate acted on a bi-partisan basis to protect the self-defense rights of citizens when those rights are most vital, in the aftermath of a major disaster, when law-abiding citizens are left to defend themselves and their families.

The language, offered by Sen. David Vitter (R-LA) as an amendment to the Homeland Security appropriations bill (HR 5441), will make it illegal for federal agents to confiscate firearms during an emergency or major disaster.

NRA-ILA Executive Director Chris W. Cox said, "After Hurricane Katrina, the New Orleans Police Superintendent issued orders to confiscate firearms from all citizens, allegedly under a state emergency powers law. With that one order, he stripped the one means of self-protection innocent citizens had during a time of widespread civil disorder. This legislation guarantees that will never happen again." "In passing this legislation, the U.S. Senate acted to protect the self-defense rights of citizens when those rights are most vital. There was no 9-1-1 or police to rely on while looters and rapists and thugs ran rampant and honest citizens were left to their own devices to protect themselves, their families and their neighbors. I want to thank Senator Vitter for introducing this amendment and all the Senators who supported it," concluded Cox.

The provision must now survive a conference committee -- where House and Senate negotiators will iron out differences between the spending bills passed in both chambers. If the Vitter language makes it to the President's desk, it will perfectly complement what has been happening in the states. This year, one of GOA's highest priorities has been to address the problems with so-called "emergency powers" across the country. Legislation prohibiting government officials from restricting the rights of law-abiding gun owners during declared states of emergency has passed this year in Louisiana, Mississippi, Florida, South Carolina, Virginia, Alaska, Idaho, Kentucky, New Hampshire, and Oklahoma. WHY NOT IN HAWAII ?

GOA-supported bills have made it absolutely certain that no government official could disarm the citizenry during an emergency, and several states -- ten in all -- have already enacted their bills into law. So who were the Senators who were arrogant enough to stand by their anti-gun convictions and vote against this common-sense legislation?

They were: Dan Akaka and Dan Inouye among the 16. Basically, these senators said that when your life is in danger, you don't have the right to defend yourself. You are just supposed to pick up the phone and dial 9-1-1. Your guns are part of the problem because they could be stolen by bad guys. And you don't need guns anyway because the police are there to protect you. These are actually the talking points from the anti-gun side of the aisle. They told the Senate -- and the country -- that YOUR guns were the problem. True in communist country, but in America Citizens have right to KBA.

How Much Profit is too much?

Molokai Ranch (MPL) Sales statistics

Sales of MPL properties/ Kaluakoi 2003-2006 \$25,342,900.00 Sales of MPL properties/ Maunaloa 2003-2006 \$9,182,856.00

Molokai Ranch (MPL) has constantly reminded us that the Sales of La'au Lots are crucial to the funding of Kaluako'i Hotel renovations as well as continuously reminding the Molokai Community of it's annually occurring 3.7 million dollar operating expense loss. What they fail to tell us is that a significant portion of these losses are based on previously poor management and investment strategies including tent camps and the lodge in Maunaloa. Also, what MPL fails to mention are it's excellent investment returns in regard to it's buy out of Kaluako'i Properties from Kukui Molokai, which MPL purchased for 9 million dollars. The increased equity of these lands has netted an equitable profit 10- 20 times what it purchased the land for. In just the last three years alone, Molokai Ranch, under the names of Molokai Acquisitions and Kaluako'i Residential has sold over 25 million dollars of residential lots in the Kaluako'i area, these lots having no additional expense outlay other than property taxes and seller fees. MPL still remains with considerable land holdings in the Kaluako'i area including a number of residential Ag parcels, the existing Hotel, existing golf course and restaurant sights, future Hotel sights, a future golf course sight, as well as acreage just north of the Kaluako'i Hotel which is designated rural and could possibly allow up to 500 additional homes or serve as expansion of the existing hotel. The 150 rooms of the hotel, without renovation, easily value at a low figure of \$200,000 a room. A low end value of 30 million dollars. Molokai Ranch (MPL) also sold over 9 million dollars of property in the Maunaloa area in the last 3 years. On top of this, the parent company has demonstrated a profit over the last two years of approximately 150 million dollars.

With these type of assets it is difficult to understand why MPL can not fund the hotel construction without the sales of La'au point lots.

In 2001 Molokai Ranch purchased the lands previously owned by Alpha USA. for the amount of 6 Million dollars, These are the lands that include the proposed 200 parcel La'au Point project. At today's market rate these lots would sell for 1-2 million dollars a lot. If the donation of 26,000 acres seems like a generous offer, we need to

While it can be said that increased equity benefits the local home buyer as well as the new investor, the fact is that most local homeowners usually do not buy and sell and consequently do not reap the benefits of increased equity. Most of the profits are made by those who come to buy and sell and treat our island as nothing more than stock in the stock market. Ultimately what does increase are property taxes. Also rent prices move up as land values increase. Affordable housing will help but will not be able to fill in the gap.

realize that most of these lands being donated to the trust are not of great value to the ranch and that in turn it is possible for the ranch to sell the lots at La'au for a total of anywhere from 200 to 400 million dollars, and if the market rises, as much as a half billion dollars could be retrieved.

While the concealing of most of this information from the Molokai community is bad enough itself, the entire plan should be of concern as it seems to follow the traditional real estate/ tourism model that has devastated the working class of other islands by driving up equity on real estate and ultimately creating a drastic increase in the local cost of living. This model works to the distinct advantage of outside inves-

tors, and for those in the real estate industry, as well as for those that already have significant financial holdings, but fails the average family. It is expected that most of the jobs created by this plan would fall in the \$10 an hour category. At this income level, if the effect of tourism on real estate drove up property values even 5% annually, the income received, as far as how earned income translates into home buying power, would be close to zero, and at this level of income the ability of buying a home would be impossible without outside help.

In regard to the proposed La'au project, it is sad that the EC, which was intended to serve the community and be the community voice, has been used by Molokai Ranch to accomplish it's purpose. The EC has failed to hear the majority voice of Molokai and in doing so has alienated itself from much of the community. We respectfully ask that the EC truly consider the long term effects of this project and the potential consequences that will effect every aspect of our island lifestyle. Extreme class separation, disregard for our culture and lifestyle, abuse of our natural resources and rising costs will be just a few of the consequences of this project. We need to begin to recognize the real value and uniqueness of our island. We are the last Hawaiian Island! If we are patient and seek what is pono, we will see business models come our way that recognize this uniqueness. Rather than be a second class Maui, we can become the island that encompasses all that is truly Hawaiian. To embrace this will be to the benefit of all!



THE COLONY

The Harrowing True Story of the Exiles of Molokai

author: John Tayman

September 13, 2001 two days after 9/11, the author, John Tayman began his journey to research, interview and write about the Molokai community of Kalaupapa. Archival material, photographs, letters, journals, as well as government documents are the basis of much of the text beginning with the 1843 story of the Kaluaikoolau of Kaua'i.



The ancient stigma of leprosy now called Hansen's Disease is integrated with the human story of suffering, isolation and medical treatment is told with compelling detail. Chapter titles "Run (population 1,143)" to the final "Stay (28)" is a part of the story of Kalaupapa. There are archival photographs and indexed notes. "The Colony" seems mostly to refer to Kalaupapa, but has roots in Carville, the Louisiana treatment facility and the approach of US and Hawaii's government to the isolation and treatment of victims of the disease known from Biblical times as leprosy. It is a non-fiction story of the horrible isolation, controversies collected in detail in this one resource.

The author in his "Source Notes" names the present day residents who were instrumental in the history, emotional and compassionate telling of life at the "nat-

ural prison" over the pali. If you've had the privilege to meet some of the residents, seen them in video documents, heard their "talk story," or seen them on the news, you hear these survivors as you read *THE COLONY*.

Though the title of the book and choice of terms by the author is not supported by some of the residents who were primary sources of information, *THE COLONY* is still a compelling story of individual bravery and extraordinary survival. Their story is heartbreaking, but a monument to the strength and character of those who continue to live and to the memory of those who lived in the special place, Kalaupapa.



Ziggy Marley's *Love is My Religion*

"This album is from my heart," says Ziggy Marley of his second solo album, *Love is My Religion* (Tuff Gong Worldwide). The twelve-track album showcases Ziggy's tightly rolled talents as a songwriter (writing all cuts), musician, and producer. Written "all over the world," with some songs penned during his youth, *Love is My Religion* is clearly reggae, peppered by African Percussion and other flavors. On the title track, "Love is My Religion," his message is one that "people need to hear," a unifying devotion to love that "needs to be preached in churches and mosque and synagogues."

Friendship is one of the album's recurring themes, whether as the core of monogamous love or the connective tissue of global brotherhood. "On the Beach in Hawaii" also offers an ode to love. Notable in "On the Beach in Hawaii" is Jake Shimabukuro on ukulele. The album closes with the simple and complex: an acoustic guitar version of "Love is My Religion" and a bass-heavy, trip-hop mix off "Be Free." The lyrics of "Be Free" are worth a listen. A native of Kingston, Jamaica, Ziggy first sat in on recording sessions with his father when he was ten years old. Joining with his three siblings to become The Melody makers, Ziggy crafted his own soulful sound blending blues, R&B, hip-hop and reggae. Ziggy has also founded U.R.G.E. (Unlimited Resources Giving

Enlightenment), a non-profit organization that benefits a wide range of charitable children's causes in Jamaica, Ethiopia and other developing nations. More recently he has thrown his support behind the Youth AIDS campaign.



Fascist No KNOCK, is Wake up?

NO KNOCK is the Road to FASCISM SWAT KNOCKING and BREAKING IN. The presumed protocol that police knock, identify themselves and then wait 15 or 20 seconds before entering, has gone the way of the 50-cent cup of coffee. It can still be found, but not often. The Joe Friday approach to conducting a search has been replaced by Rambo in riot gear because years earlier the high court permitted the waiver of the "knock and announce" requirement - a rule grounded in our 4th Amendment privacy rights - in almost every circumstance. If there's a chance that evidence will be destroyed, such as the possibility of drugs being flushed down the toilet, or a potential for physical violence - police suspecting there is a gun in the home, for instance - the Supreme Court has said it is not necessary to give advanced notice of entry.

We now have plenty of experience with "no-knock" warrants, as they are called, and the trail of victims this terrorizing tactic has left behind. Radley Balko, a policy analyst at the libertarian Cato Institute, says that he has documented nearly 200 cases of "wrong door" raids occurring in the last 15 years, where the police broke into an innocent person's house. He says the correct figure is probably higher, but police and prosecutors don't generally bother keeping statistics on the operations they botch.

And when police come charging through the wrong door, they aren't dressed in a trench-coat and Dockers. These raids are typically conducted by militarized SWAT teams, outfitted for war. They are dressed in black masks and carry military-issue automatic weapons and other paramilitary gear, obtained gratis from the Pentagon. People who experienced such a raid must have felt like they were being attacked by an invading army. It isn't any wonder that, as in war, there is significant "collateral damage." Balko has counted two dozen innocent people who died during one of these raids.

We all know about the Kaapuni's No Knock experience with MPD and Maui VIC, so let's see some of the more notorious Mainland examples include the 1994 case of 75-year-old retired Methodist minister Accelyne Williams, who was reading a Bible in his living room when Boston police crashed through his door with sledge hammers. He died of a heart attack after being wrestled to the ground and handcuffed.

Similarly in 2003, Alberta Spruill, a 57-year-old employee of New York City, died after police battered her door in and threw a concussion grenade inside. The coroner ruled that Spruill's death was a homicide. She had been scared to death. Sometimes, the victim gets shot because his natural reaction to an invasion by gun-toting masked men is to reach for a firearm himself.

Is this highly confrontational tactic really necessary to secure evidence or ensure police safety when serving drug warrants? Not in the least, Jack Cole says. Cole is the executive director of Law Enforcement Against Prohibition (<http://www.leap.cc>), an international drug-policy reform group made up of former drug warriors - police, prosecutors, wardens - who believe the U.S. War on Drugs has been a destructive failure. He is also a retired detective lieutenant and undercover narcotics investigator who spent 26 years with the New Jersey State Police.

According to Cole, "too much violence is instigated by the police and it's just not necessary" to do the job. Cole says a war metaphor has no place in domestic policing in a democratic society. When there is a war, there has to be an enemy, Cole says, and since 110 million people in this country above the age of 12 have admitted to having used an illegal drug, "The enemy is us." Cole says that whenever he served a warrant, he was able to come up with some ruse to get an occupant to open the door without breaking it down or using violence. "You just don't have to go in as a SWAT team," Cole says.

SWAT teams have proliferated not because they are needed but because police like to play soldier with relatively little of the battlefield risk; and they have been goosed along by a federal government that hands out surplus military implements like candy.

The only backstop to all this has been the U.S. Supreme Court and its rulings establishing basic standards for police interactions with the public. But with the Hudson case, it is pretty clear there is a five-member majority for loosening whatever reins still exist. So, expect the "war" to get more bloody and its casualty list to get longer.

On June 15th, the black robed bandits, ruling from the lofty perch of infallibility, issued an edict that prohibits the exclusion of evidence gained from illegal searches by law enforcement entities. In doing so, they also brought the aura of near infallibility to those in law enforcement.

The very idea that the Supremes justify their insanity on the belief that "increasing professionalism of police forces, including a new emphasis on internal police discipline" justifies no-knock dynamic entries is truly alarming. The law enforcement travesties known as Ruby Ridge and Waco, and the total ineptitude and chaos that was Columbine have obviously been forgotten.

The no-knock warrant is most often used in routine searches for illegal drugs. What should be of great concern, not only to the Supreme Court, but also to American citizens, is the increasing dependence on notoriously unreliable "confidential informants" by law enforcement agencies in obtaining such warrants.

This reliability, as a premise for the issuance of a search warrant, has led to a plethora of "wrong address" warrants over the past decade. The number of innocent "suspects" actually killed in this type of raid is, in itself, a crime of major concern. There are estimates that put the number of wrong-door warrants at over 200. These are only those that are reported, or those that led to injuries or death, of either the occupants of the home being invaded or the police who were conducting the raid.

Nothing in this realm could be considered fair and balanced. What are the chances of some "confidential informant" giving the police or the FBI the address of any of the Supreme Court Justices on drugs, or even your local drug using prosecuting attorney or mayor, and a follow-up raid actually taking place? You can bet that you or I would not be afforded the same exclusion.

The standing rule should be: if law enforcement would not risk their careers by raiding the sacrosanct Chief of Police's home on the word of their informant, they damn well better not risk their life raiding mine.

And the affidavit required to be with the Warrant must not be sealed by some hypocrite judge who give not a damn about the Constitution for the United States of America.

Why Do Good Men Do Nothing?

In his book *Thoughts on the Cause of Present Discontents* (1770), the British philosopher Edmund Burke wrote, "When bad men combine, the good must associate; else they will fall one by one." This sentiment has survived as "All that is necessary for evil to succeed is that good men do nothing."

Why do good men do nothing in the face of evil, especially when evil aggressively invades their lives?

The question has red-hot relevance to those who value the tradition of individual freedom into which America was born -- a tradition that includes freedom of speech, the right to bear arms and to demand due process. These traditional freedoms are crumbling under the wheels of run-away government. Through dozens of 'alphabet agencies' -- the IRS, BATF, CPS, DHS, et al -- government aggression enters the lives of good men who do nothing to protect themselves or their families.

Some people are paralyzed by fear; some by denial. But many others are immobilized by an apathy that strips away the emotional will to act in self-defense.

In psychological terms, apathy is a state of constant indifference that is generally associated with depression. Apathy leaves an individual unresponsive to the world and creates a disconnect between what he believes, how he feels and which actions he takes. For example, a man might fully recognize that food is necessary to life but, because he doesn't care, he doesn't eat.

Translated into political terms, he might realize that a gluttonous government is feasting on his liberty, his wealth and even on his children's future but, because he feels only numbness toward government, he doesn't act in self-defense. He obeys even when the command is self-destructive. The question of why people passively obey government has haunted the history of political discourse. In 1552, Etienne de la Boetie addressed what he called the most important problem confronting freedom: people consent to their own enslavement. His analysis of 'why' resulted in the world's first book on non-violent resistance, *The Politics of Obedience: The Discourse of Voluntary Servitude*.

Modern historians ask the same question. During the mass arrests of Stalinist Russia, people reportedly slept in their clothing not in order to flee more easily but in order to be fully dressed when seized. In Hitler's Europe, Jews reported on their own to deportation centers and to their deaths. Why? Part of the complex answer lies in what psychologists call 'object specific' apathy. That is, a person's numbness is directed toward a specific situation and may not be manifested in other areas of his life. The same man who is passionate about music or his wife may feel impotent in the area of demanding or even wanting his own freedom. This response is a form of 'learned helplessness.' It is 'learned' because the response comes from relentlessly teaching an individual that he has no control over a situation and, so, his efforts are futile.

The original and now-famous experiment from which the term 'learned helplessness' derives involved shocking dogs with electricity until they developed the psychology of submission. When applied to human beings, 'learned helplessness' is most often used to describe people who have been institutionalized, for example, in prisons, mental institutions or orphanages. There, the regimentation strips an individual of the smallest choice and punishes the expression of preference. In time, many institutionalized people accept the inevitability of their environment. Some of them lose all ability to feel their own preferences.

The depth of learned helplessness that comes from being institutionalized is rare. But most of us absorb a degree of this apathy through constant exposure to a society that attempts to control almost every choice in daily life: smoking, eating fast food, gun ownership, telling a rude joke at work, marriage and divorce, boarding an airplane, medical care, banking -- making a phone call. It is difficult to find a choice that isn't scrutinized by bureaucracy and covered by some form of government control. The message is clear: Conformity is rewarded; the 'wrong' choices are punished or otherwise discouraged. The public school system is just one example of what could be called the institutionalizing or bureaucratizing of daily life.

The Castle, a brilliant novel by Franz Kafka, offers a window into what happens to the psychology of a man who confronts bureaucracy. Due to a mistake in paperwork, the main character K. is summoned to work in a village as a surveyor but ends up as a janitor. The Castle is the summoning authority with which K. must but cannot deal because he cannot contact the proper official. K.'s long and agonizing exercise in futility reveals the impact that bureaucracy has upon the human soul: it deadens. K.'s error was to accept the authority of The Castle in the first place. The foregoing observation contains good news: bureaucracy and authority require consent. And, if that consent is learned behavior, then it can also be unlearned.

Something within the human spirit seems to want to shake off destructive programming. Call it a survival instinct. Perhaps it is the inbred urge revealed by every two-year-old who yells 'no' over and over again for the simple joy of exercising veto over his own life.

Adults need to recapture the childlike joy and power of saying 'no.' The words most feared by those in authority are 'I won't.' Individuals with the habit of obedience may need to start by saying 'no' on small matters like refusing to fill in racial information on application forms. They may be shocked by how difficult it is to say 'I won't' even to petty demands. But the difficulty is a sign of how important it is. Only when a person is able to say 'no' can he say 'yes' and have the word mean more than the obedient response of a servant.


