Five Students Win Scholarship: Make Plans to “Give Back” to their Community

Whitney Apo of Molokai will major in Nursing in Southern Oregon University with the goal of becoming a Certified Nurse Midwife. By volunteering at the local hospital, Whitney learned that midwives do most of the birthing deliveries on Molokai. “Midwives have the honor of bringing new life into this world, and to help families plan for the future,” she said. “I have chosen to commit myself to this career in health for both my own family as well as my community.”

“I hope this scholarship will inspire Maui’s youth to return home and share their skills here on the island-- where they can make a difference,” said Josh, who returned to Maui in 2002, after graduating from the University of Washington, for a career helping home buyers and sellers. Josh works as a broker with Century 21 All Islands-- The Shops at Wailea, and donated five percent of his earned income on every sale to the scholarship fund, and five percent to the Maui charity of his client’s choice.

When Baldwin-graduate **Daniel Ho** was in seventh grade, he lost all vision in his left eye as a result of bully’s attack. As he worked with doctors to repair the injury, Daniel learned not to take anything for granted. He also gained a deep desire to help others-- much in the same way his own doctors helped him. Daniel has chosen his path: He will study optometry at the University of Hawaii at Manoa beginning this Fall and return to Maui after graduation.

Daniel is one of five high school seniors awarded \$1,000 each by the Josh Jerman Realtor Maui Scholarship 2008. Others scholarship winners include Elmer Ahtarap of Lanai High School; Carli Owan of Kamehameha School of Maui; and Ashley Ventimiglia of King Kekaulike High School. In its fourth consecutive year, the Josh Jerman Realtor Maui Scholarship encourages college-bound students to use their education to benefit Maui County. More than 50 students applied for this scholarship. A selection committee reviewed student applications, rating them by financial need, academics, community involvement and a student essay describing how they planned to use their education.

Homeland Security Nazi Threatens Governor of Montana and The People

“Do you want our government to have the ability to track where you went, how you went, how you got there and when you got home? It would be naïve for someone to think this information will not be abused in the future. Virtually every decade these kinds of files have been used to violate people’s privacy.”

Brian Schweitzer, the governor of Montana, wrote a letter to Homeland Security Secretary Michael Chertoff. The letter informed Chertoff that Montana would not be complying with the REAL ID Act. In response to the letter Secretary Chertoff called Governor Schweitzer and threatened him. Chertoff told Schweitzer that Montana residents would be banned from airplanes, or subjected to severe, time-consuming inspections at airports.

The Governor countered with his own threat, “How about we both go on 60 Minutes a few days after the DHS starts patting down Montana driver’s license-holders who are trying to get on the planes and both of us can tell our side of the story.” Chertoff didn’t like that suggestion. He said, “I see the problem. We need to get this fixed.”

So far, the “fix” involves granting Montana and all other rebellious states an extension of the deadline for complying with the REAL ID Act. But the real fix that is needed is to repeal REAL ID, and repeal TWIC, and repeal TSA.

Have you protested to your elected representatives that the Secretary of Homeland Security has been threatening the citizens of states that don’t comply with REAL ID? If not, please do so. You can mention the Chertoff-Schweitzer exchange in your personal comments. Ask Congress to repeal the REAL ID Act.

A recent story in USA Today reported that the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) may weigh in on the issue of legal gun carry in the unsecured areas of airports.

It was reported that TSA “may allow airports to ban firearms from terminals, parking lots, roads and other airport areas where many states currently allow passengers to carry . . .” Such a policy would not only interfere with self-defense rights, but could also interfere with the possession of legal firearms by hunters and other travelers who plan to check those firearms in their luggage.

Please be sure to contact TSA to let them know that their interference with local Right-to-Carry laws is unwanted and an unneeded infringement on the right to self-defense, and the 2nd Amendment Right to keep and bear arms.

Baby Boy **Kyson Ambrose Mana O'Kaleo**

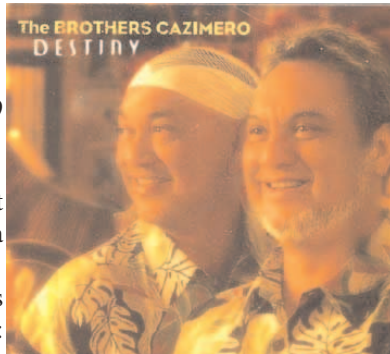

The goal of the founders of America was to restrict government within severe limits and to protect the rights of sovereign individuals. Government has NO rights!

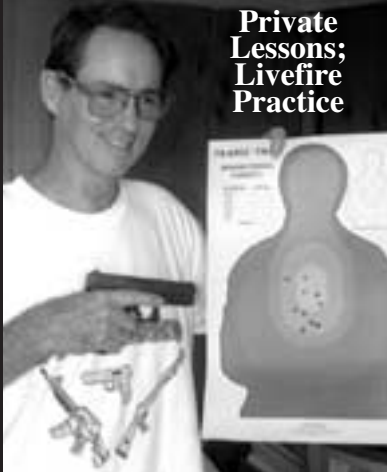

"A well regulated militia, being necessary to the security of a free state, the right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed." Exercise the 2nd Amendment.

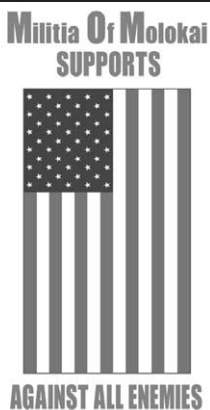

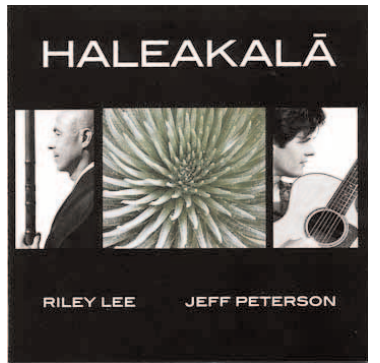

New CD Release *Haleakala* Jeff Peterson (ki ho'alu) and Riley Lee (shakuhachi)

Maui native Jeff Peterson, the 2008 Na Hoku Hanohano Award winner for the Instrumental Album of the Year and the ki ho'alu slack key guitarist of the year, recently released HALEAKALA with shakuhachi Grand Master Riley Lee.



Peterson and Lee, both accomplished artists with a passion for two distinct musical traditions -- Hawaiian slack key and the Japanese bamboo flute, respectively-- have collaborated to reveal a sound that is not only genuine and original, but inspired. The shakuhachi's rich tonal pallet blends beautifully with the gentle nahenahe sounds of Peterson's ki ho'alu.

Familiar Hawaiian songs featured on Haleakala have been given new life and fresh, new interpretations. Beloved Hawaiian standards like "Akaka Falls," "Sanoe," and "Pua 'Ahihi" pay tribute to the rich heritage of the Hawaiian islands ad the people of Hawai'i. Four new compositions, three written by Peterson and a collaboration with Lee, honor the breathtaking beauty of Haleakala.

Born on Maui, Jeff Peterson grew up on Haleakala Ranch, where his father a paniolo introduced to him the rich heritage of Hawaiian music. Peterson was deeply impacted by his father's music as well as the ki ho'alu he heard on recordings by the Gabby Pahinui Band, Leonard Kwan, and Sonny Chillingworth. He has studied jazz and classical guitar at the University of Southern California and the University of Hawaii- Manoa. He has studied privately with a wide variety of artists including Classical guitarist Benjamin Verdery, slack key guitarist Ozzie Kotani and a number of jazz guitarists.

Texan by birth, Riley Lee moved to Hawaii with his family and lived in Honolulu until 1986 when he moved to Australia with his partner/manager Patricia and two daughters. While traveling in Japan in 1970, Riley began playing the shakuhachi. His music studies included such peculiar methods as practicing bare-foot in the snow, blowing his flute under waterfalls and in blizzards until icicles formed at its end and running marathon. In 1980, he became the first ever non-Japanese shakuhachi dai shihan (Grand Master). Riley has a Phd in musicology from Sydney University. Over 50 of his recordings have been released on international labels.

For generations, Japanese culture has been a key influence in the islands. Haleakala, a project that could only come from Peterson and Lee, is a synergistic representation of that influence.
