Argentina and Mexico End Drug Prohibition, but Obama's War on Drugs Rolls On

In the Argentine section of the global cannabis nation, it was a happy day last week when Drug Prohibition ruled unconstitutional. "Wow! This feels like honest good vibrations from the Supreme Court and the government," said Argentine marijuana activist Mike Bifari. "They really do have this new policy of generally being more tolerant and talking about human rights in the drug issue nationally and internationally, instead of that tired old war on drugs."

The Argentine Supreme Court declared that the country's drug law that criminalizes drug possession is unconstitutional. While the ruling referred only to marijuana possession, the portion of the law it threw out includes all drugs.

Imprisoning people absent harm to others violated constitutional protections, a unanimous court held. "Each individual adult is responsible for making decisions freely about their desired lifestyle without state interference," their ruling said. "Private conduct is allowed unless it constitutes a real danger or causes damage to property or the rights of others. The state cannot establish morality."

The ruling confirms the paradigm shift visible throughout the continent, which recognizes that drug use should be treated as a public health matter instead of, as taught by DARE that all involved, including users, were seen as criminals.

"What's happened in Mexico and now Argentina is very consistent with the broader trend in Europe and Latin America in terms of decriminalizing small amounts of drugs and promoting alternatives to incarceration and a public health approach for people struggling with drug addiction," said Ethan Nadelmann, executive director of the Drug Policy Alliance.

Drug prohibition enforcement in USA is way out of touch with rational reality. Obama's hard-line drug policies are increasingly isolated in the hemisphere. This is happening all over Latin America. You'd think we might be able to do it here, in USA, the so called "Land of the Free".

Mexico legalizes drug possession August 20

Mexico enacted a controversial law on Thursday decriminalizing possession of small amounts of marijuana, cocaine, heroin and other drugs while encouraging government-financed treatment for

The law sets out maximum "personal use" amounts for drugs, also including LSD and methamphetamine. People detained with those quantities will no longer face criminal prosecution; the law goes into effect on Friday.

Anyone caught with drug amounts under the personal-use limit will be encouraged to seek treatment, and for those caught a third time treatment is mandatory — although no penalties for noncompliance are specified.

The maximum amount of marijuana considered to be for "personal use" under the new law is 5 grams — the equivalent of about four marijuana cigarettes. Other limits are half a gram of cocaine, 50 milligrams of heroin, 40 milligrams for methamphetamine and 0.015 milligrams of LSD.

President Felipe Calderón waited months before approving the law.

Maybe the violence and killing will abate after end of prohibition. Total reported body count for this year: 4,587 dead.

Mexico can do it, why can't OBAMA? He promised end to medical marijuana DEA raids, but the raids continue. The Mexican law aims at getting people into treatment. If we did it, think of what we would save in prison expenses, not to mention all the expenses of enforcement.

The political crusade to wipe out drug use in the US has had many unforeseen consequences - not least the development of a corrections system with almost 2m people in prison and 4.6m on parole and probation. About 24 per cent of them are serving sentences for drug possession or sale.

As the nation's prison population approaches the 2m mark, the so-called "prison industrial complex", which builds, supplies and guards penitentiaries, has lobbied for a tough line on long-term incarceration for more profits.


"Drug policy has been driven more by politics than policy," said Congressman Ted Strickland, who once worked as a prison psychologist. "The drug war has made it necessary for prisons to expand and caused the private prison industry to be born. That industry works aggressively in building prisons and getting public dollars to support them." Crime does pay, and pay is BIG !!

Police and federal agents also like the drug war. Under controversial "asset forfeiture" rules, aimed at drug "king pins", they can keep a share of the profits when they seize houses, cars, boats, cash and other property of suspected drug offenders. This has produced widespread corruption and mistreatment, documented in many reports.

Open Letter to Obama

Dear "President" Obama by State Representative Samuel E. Rohrer - PA]

Many of your words, at face value, inspire and offer some level of hope. This is why many Americans cast their vote for you. Yet, now that you are in office, your actions are inspiring fear and distrust. At nearly every level, Americans, regardless of political party, are being forced to walk down the same road our Founders were forced to walk – questioning, analyzing, and looking deep within their souls.

The similarities between the past and the present are amazing. If you desire to test the American people's resolve and challenge their patience, you are accomplishing your goal. You know what is happening within the hearts and minds of the average American. 9th Circuit Court rules possessing gun while growing marijuana is a FELONY and you have NO 2nd Amendment Rights

A federal appeals court has ruled that simply carrying a weapon while growing marijuana is a crime in itself.

The 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals affirmed the conviction of a Medford-area man who argued that keeping a .45 caliber semiautomatic pistol within reach while sleeping in a tent at a marijuana operation was not a separate crime.

Somkhit Thongsy was charged with possession of a firearm in furtherance of a felony after U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration agents raided a large marijuana farm in the remote Wolf Creek area of Southern Oregon in the spring of 2007. The appeals court ruled Monday August 17, 2009 that the evidence the pistol was part of the drug operation was overwhelming, and it was not used for hunting or kept in the tent by accident.

Keep in mind here that as far as the 9th Circuit and the federal courts are concerned, all marijuana grows are a felony. So you state-registered medical marijuana growers in Hawaii, California, Oregon, and Washington covered by the 9th Circuit, you are on notice: you have no federal 2nd Amendment rights anymore.

How you figga? Just last year, the Supreme Court ruled in DC v. Heller that the 2nd Amendment guarantees a personal right to a firearm: In a 5-4 decision, the Court held that the Second Amendment protects an individual right to possess a firearm unconnected with service in a militia, and to use that firearm for traditionally lawful purposes, such as self-defense within the home.

Isn't it weird to think that the 9th Circuit Court would have had Thomas Jefferson and George Washington busted for the muskets they kept near their hemp plantations?

Gunowner Exercises 2nd Am Right at Obama Health Care rally in Arizona

A man was walking around with a pistol on his hip and an AR-15 semi-automatic rifle on a strap over his shoulder during the pro-health care reform rally in Arizona where Obama was speaking last week. Apparently his guns were not a threat to Obama, rather a pro-gun rights demonstration Obama's anti-gun stance.

"Because I can do it," he said when asked why he was armed. "In Arizona, I still have some freedoms." Two police officers were staying very close to the man. "What he is doing is perfectly legal," Det. J. Oliver, of the Phoenix Police Department said. "We are here to keep the peace. If we need to intervene, we will intervene at that time."

Thousands of citizens legally growing medical marijuana for disabled people are not allowed to have firearms and every home invasion robber knows that and the cops are too busy keeping an eye on demonstrators lawfully and peacefully holding guns to do anything about stopping home invasions.



The goal of the founders of America was to restrict government within severe limits and to protect the rights of sovereign individuals. Government has NO rights!

Cats & Dogs in China Are Killed for Fur

PETA reports that every year, millions of individual animals, including more than 2 million cats and hundreds of thousands of dogs, are killed for their fur in China. Some are strays, and countless others are companions who once shared homes with people who loved and cared for them before the animals captured with metal tongs around their necks—and tossed, screaming, into a crate.

A timid young rabbit waits, terrified, in a cramped, filthy wire cage. Suddenly, a hand reaches in and roughly grabs her. Her neck is broken. She is then tossed, still convulsing, into a barrel. When it's filled, the barrel is wheeled into another room, where she is skinned.

This horrific abuse is happening right now to countless rabbits ... and cats and dogs ... on Chinese fur farms and in Chinese markets. Won't you please help us stop this massive cruelty?

China is one of the world's largest fur suppliers, and more than 95 percent of the country's finished garments are exported—with many ending up in North America. And as we now know, Chinese companies have been known to deliberately mislabel cat and dog fur as "Asian jackal," "rabbit," or "raccoon" to fool consumers. Every fur-trimmed collar or other fur item from China, regardless of the kind of animal slaughtered to manufacture it, is the product of cruelty on a truly massive scale. And we must combat it!

We need your help right now. Please make an urgently needed donation to PETA today and help us stop the horrific slaughter of cats, dogs, and other animals for their skin. The suffering on Chinese fur farms involves all sorts of animals, all of whom are deeply frightened.

Powerful video footage taken during a PETA Asia-Pacific undercover investigation documents the misery of rabbits condemned to a short, miserable life and painful death at the hands of grubby fur-farm operators. The investigator saw rabbits who were crammed into filthy cages covered with urine and feces, where they could only wait, petrified, as workers made their way along the tiers of cages.
