1986 Molokai Sakadas Celebration Commemorated the 40th Anniversary of the arrival of 1946 Filipino Contract Workers

2006 marks the Centennial Celebration of Filipinos in Hawaii. One hundred years ago, Filipinos immigrated to Hawaii seeking a new life and a new means of earning money to take care of their families.

With promises of the Sugar Plantation Growers, thousands of Filipinos were hired to work the sugar and pineapple fields. They endured a long, difficult, cramped conditions on their long boat ride from their homeland.

One in Hawaii, the Sakadas' existence was equally tough. Working and living conditions were challenging. Earning less than a dollar a day, and working 12 hours a day, were daily contract expectations of the Sakada. The separation from family back in their motherland was hardship many experienced.

And yet for the last 100 years, Filipinos helped to build Hawaii. Their contributions have led to many successes. Many prominent Filipinos have risen from the ranks of laborers to become professionals. Filipinos are educators, bankers, lawyers, doctors, attorneys, police officers, tradesmen, nurses, politicians and a governor of the State. Filipinos have made a difference through their contributions in the community,

Vince Bagoyo, Jr. has stated, "Throughout history, let us never forget that our Sakada are the living bridge across three generations of Filipino heritage, Pinoy pride, and the living work in progress, yet to be



created by our generations in the beyond. Filipinos has bigger dreams, which are yet to come."

The year long celebration was kicked off on Molokai at the end of 2005 at the annual Rizal Day Program with 1946 Sakadas Juan Trinidad and Pastor Batara as speakers.

Gun Rights Protection In EMERGENCY LAW

NRA and law-abiding gun owners won another major victory July 25 when the U.S. House of Representatives voted to pass HR 5013, the NRA-backed "Disaster Recovery Personal Protection Act."

Unfortunately, Hawaii reps, Neil Abercrombie and Ed Case voted AGAINST gun rights, again.

"Today the House of Representatives reaffirmed that in times of disaster you cannot throw out the Constitutional amendment that guarantees the right of the people to keep and bear arms. In the days following Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, confiscations and prohibitions, and the means by which they were carried out, deprived law-abiding citizens of Louisiana not only of

their right to keep and bear arms, but also of their rights to personal security, personal liberty, and private property, all in violation of the Constitution and laws of the United States. My legislation will prevent this from happening during future disasters."

The bill -- introduced by Rep. Bobby Jindal (R-LA) -- is similar to the Vitter amendment which passed the Senate earlier this month.

GOA has kept its members abreast of Jindal's important bill (HR 5013), as it would legislatively block federal agents from confiscating firearms during an emergency. Jindal's language would even give aggrieved gun owners a cause of action in federal court to recover their firearms and would recompense victorious plaintiffs for their attorney's fees.

Both the House and Senate have passed Emergency Protection language, albeit in different forms. So GOA will keep you updated on progress related to this important legislation.

In other news, the House Judiciary Committee was

supposed to consider McCarthy's Brady Enhancement legislation, H.R. 1415, this past Wednesday. This bill will spend millions of dollars to further prop up the unconstitutional Brady Law and would allow the federal government to troll through state misdemeanor, diversion, psychiatric, tax, and even library records -- all for the purpose of finding new reasons to seize guns from law-abiding Americans.

You can bet all of Hawaii's federal delegation Inouye, Akaka, Case, Abercrombie will continue their voting records against Americans' right to keep and bear arms unless they are voted out of office. What don't they understand about the Bill of Rights 2nd Amendment "...shall not be infringed": **"A well regulated militia being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed."**

Wake up militia! Use it, or lose it!

Lanai's Kaunalapau Harbor Project Needs Molokai Rocks, and Water (for dust control)

This Thanksgiving, the community of Lanai have waited 24 years, since Hurricane Iwa damaged the breakwater at Kaunalapau Harbor. Located on the leeward coast of the island of Lanai, Kaunalapau is the only barge harbor receiving supplies for the island. It is the community's lifeline. When a barge cannot make its weekly stop, store shelves are bare. Fresh milk, eggs and other necessities are depleted. The Island's fuel supply for vehicles and electric generation is reduced to a 10 day window.

An Information Paper about "Molokai Contributions to the Kaunalapau Project" was issued on July 6, 2006 by the US Army Corps of Engineers, Honolulu District.

"1. Purpose: To provide information on the rocks and water supply on the island of

Molokai for the construction of the Kaunalapau Harbor project, under construction by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Honolulu District.

2. Rock for Underlayer

Lanai Supply. The rock available on Lanai was found to be inadequate (field stone strength).

Tonnage. About 35,000 tons of rocks are needed (25,000 tons from Molokai) for the approximately 320-ft. long (new) breakwater. The original plan was to obtain stones from the Grace Pacific quarry, but the 5-10% yield was too low.

Sources. Arrangements with several private sources are being made. These arrangements include securing grading permits.

3. Water for Rock Removal

Permit & Conditions. To quarry field stones, a grading permit is required and a normal requirement is for environmental remediation (dust control).

Usage. Approximately 12-14,000 gallons per day for about 90 days will be required for dust control (over a 15-week period).

Special Permit. The Corps' prime contractor, Traylor Pacific, is requesting a special use permit from the Maui Department of Water Supply. The contractor will observe all special terms and conditions imposed by the County. Due to a suspension in issuance of this type of permit, Lanai Councilmember Rikki Hokama and the Corps are making a special appeal on behalf of the Lanai community to ensure the construction project proceeds.

4. Key Considerations

November completion. The project must be finished before December to avoid any risk of winter wave damage during construction. Once the old/existing structure is modified to allow placement of the artificial armor units (i.e. construction started), the protection against northwesterly wave action will be seriously reduced. In addition, if the artificial armor units are not properly interlocked through its completion, there may exist a real possibility of units unraveling leading to catastrophic failure. Damage before completion of construction could mean a multi-million dollar setback. The urgency to complete construction cannot be over-emphasized."



Dear Senator Sarbanes,

As a native Marylander and excellent customer of the Internal Revenue Service, I am writing to ask for your assistance. I have contacted the Immigration and Naturalization Service in an effort to determine the process for becoming an illegal alien and they referred me to you.

My reasons for wishing to change my status from U.S. Citizen to illegal alien stem from the bill which was recently passed by the Senate and for which you voted. If my understanding of this bill's provisions is accurate, as an illegal alien who has been in the United States for five years, what I need to do to become a citizen is to pay a \$2,000 fine and income taxes for three of the last five years. I know a good deal when I see one and I am anxious to get the process started before everyone figures it out. Simply put, those of us who have been here legally and have had to pay taxes every year so I'm excited about the prospect of avoiding two years of taxes in return for paying a \$2,000 fine. Is there any way that I can apply to be illegal retroactively? This would yield an excellent result for me and my family because we paid heavy taxes in 2004 and 2005.

Another benefit in gaining illegal status would be that my daughter would receive preferential treatment relative to her law school applications.

If you would provide me with an outline of the process to become illegal (retroactively if possible) and copies of the necessary forms, I would be most appreciative. Thank you for your assistance.

Threats Against Judges Are on the Rise

Threats against federal judges are on a record-setting pace this year, nearly 18 months after the family of a federal judge was killed in Chicago.

Threats and inappropriate communications have quadrupled over 10 years ago. There were 201 reported such incidents in the 1996 government spending year and 943 in the year that ended Sept. 30, the Marshals Service said.

This year alone, the Marshals Service has had 822 reports of inappropriate communications and threats, a pace that would top 1,000 for the year.

A threat typically includes a direct reference to harm, a weapon, or a violent act. Inappropriate communications range from rambling letters to accusations of bias to envelopes that contain feces.

Marshals say a portion of the increase can be attributed to a heightened focus by judges and their staffs since the February 2005 incident in which unemployed electrician Bart Ross broke into the home of U.S. District Judge Joan Lefkow and shot to death her husband and mother.

Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg revealed in February that she and former Justice Sandra Day O'Connor were threatened a year ago by someone who called on the Internet for the immediate "patriotic" killing of the justices.

The rise in civil lawsuits, especially those filed by people who do not have legal help, and a change in criminal cases in federal courts explain the rise, Marshals say.

Donald Donovan, chief deputy marshal in Baltimore, said people who file and lose multiple lawsuits account for the largest percentage of threats. "They don't agree with the outcome of cases. They feel betrayed by the judges and the whole system. Prout said he is in regular contact with state and local counterparts to identify people who may be moving between courts at all levels, their frustration with the legal system rising because of perceived injustices and biased judges and attorneys.

Federal courts now handle many more violent crime prosecutions, the sorts of cases that were the province of state and local courts as recently as 10 years ago.

"There is rarely a trial now that does not have defendants eligible for the death penalty," Donovan said.

The most notable change that grew out of complaints was the decision by Congress to set aside \$12 million to install security systems in judges' homes.

Lingle's Dispatch Toady Todd: Propagandist

But, given Lingle's addiction to corporate campaign contributions, her veto isn't at all surprising, but Voters know it is dirty politics.

Too bad Dispatcher Toady Todd and McAfee's MIT-Squeeze won't report it, but you can always count on reading the truth in The MAN. —George Peabody, editor.
