SOHI-Molokai Area Director Jonnette Spencer and three of our Molokai Special Olympics athletes (Federico & Lillian Galano, and Stanley Podlenski) and myself arrived early Thursday morning at Lahaina Safeway at about 5:45 am setting up for the three day of Cop on Top.

At the same time, Molokai Special Olympic had a table set up in front of Friendly Market Center as well, with lots of great volunteers for all those days!

In Lahaina, Captain Milton Matsuoka arrived on Thursday evening to climb onto the balcony of Safeway for three days and a goal of \$10,000 to bring him down. We were joined by Uncle Sonny and Aunt Betty Tabilangan who came to show us their support and to help out. We were also fortunate to have some of Maui Special Olympians who lived in the Lahaina area to help out as well. We had all three entrances into the Lahaina Cannery covered by athletes and volunteers working the crowd asking for donations to help bring our captain down.

As the day progressed into the evening Milton's wife Lisa and daughter Miki along with her mother who brought his dinner and a few of his friends who spent some time with him. Milton's daughter also worked the crowd wearing her t-shirt her mother Lisa made for her with a saying "My Pop's On Top". Miki also joined Aunt Jonnette singing karaoke to pass the time away as we continued asking people to show their support by donating anything from their loose change to a few dollars.

Early Friday morning we were joined by our own athlete mother Candice Gorman who brought a spunky youthfulness and helped work the crowd, but most importantly she kept track of the amount money we collected for the next two days. As the buckets came in we could mark our thermometer. Again the athletes and volunteers from Molokai and Maui worked hard at all entrances including the Safeway entrance asking for donation. Sometime around 12pm and again later that afternoon, I put a call out to our Molokai gang to check and see how things were going. That evening we were joined by two volunteer coaches Teddy Sotelo and Richard Rodriguez. Giving us the boost we needed so badly because as the long day progress into the early evening we were all getting tired. This night Lisa, Miki and Milton's friend and fellow officers took to the karaoke machine belting out a few songs including "Molokai Slide" as we continued to work the crowd. By the time we all got back to our hotel late that night, we all knew that we had to work hard on Saturday to meet our goal.

Saturday morning we were out in full force knowing this was day to make it happen. We were all feeling the adrenalin rush, for our flight out of Maui was at 5:20. We were confident we were going to make our goal.

At around 9am I called our gang at Friendly Market Center in Kaunakakai, telling them exactly how much more needed to reach our goal. At 11:30 we were given a treat by the Taiko Drummers. This group was made up of 15 children including Captain Matsuoka's daughter. The group put on a wonderful show in support to our Special Olympics. It was a way to draw the crowd out from the mall; it was at this time that our athletes and coaches worked the crowd for donations while watched the awesome performance.



While this was going on Candice was doing her thing counting away, shortly thereafter the performance Candice called me over-- WE WERE OVER THE TOP. I looked at my watch, it was 11:46am, and tears came to my eyes as I looked up to Milton calling out "We're over the top." With a surprised look and smile, he held up his hands, for he too

could not believe that we made it before 12pm that day. At about 12:09 we all (family and friends included) chanted to him "come on down". Milton climbed down from his perch that was his home for three days and was embraced by his loving wife and daughter and later was joined by his many friends who came to show their support to this very special man. This was Milton's last service he provided to Molokai for he was just transferred back to Maui.

No words could express my gratitude and appreciation of what this dynamic man had done for us. He gave of his time and sacrifice of three days and two nights with 5 minute bathroom breaks to help our Molokai Special Olympics raise the \$10,000 that each delegation throughout the State of Hawaii had to do. I tip my hat off to all those policemen and policewomen who gave of their time to a special cause and who believe in what we do for our special athletes. We send a big MAHALO to Milton, his family and friends for being there with us for those three days, when we needed it the most.

Radioactive Wounds of War

Tests on returning troops suggest serious health consequences of U.S. military depleted uranium use in Iraq

Gerard Matthew, 31, thought he was lucky. He returned from his Iraq tour a year and a half ago alive and in one piece. He asked to be tested for depleted uranium (DU) contamination, and since he'd spent much of his time in Iraq lugging around DU-damaged equipment, he tested highly radioactive. Matthew's wife got an ultrasound check of their unborn baby, and discovered the fetus had a condition common to those with radioactive exposure: Atypical Syndactyly. The right hand had only two digits.

Matthew feels guilty for causing her deformity and angry at the US military that never warned him about DU's dangers, lied to him it was safe.

The problem is that when DU hits its target, it throwing off clouds of microscopic particles that poison a wide area and remain radioactive for billions of years. If inhaled, these particles can lodge in lungs, other organs or bones, irradiating tissue and causing cancers. Worse yet, uranium is also a highly toxic heavy metal.

According to Mt. Sinai pathologist Thomas Fasey, who participated in the New York Guard unit testing, the element has an affinity for bonding with DNA, where even trace amounts can cause cancers and fetal abnormalities.

U.S. forces first used DU in the 1991 Gulf War, when some 300 tons of depleted uranium--the waste product of nuclear power plants and weapons facilities--were used in tank shells and shells fired by A-10 jets.

But in the current wars in Afghanistan and, especially, Iraq, DU has become the weapon of choice, with more than 1,000 tons used in Afghanistan and more than 3,000 tons used in Iraq. And while DU was fired mostly in the desert during the Gulf War, in the current war in Iraq, most of DU munitions are exploding in populated urban areas.


The Pentagon has expanded DU beyond tank and A-10 shells, for use in bunker-busting bombs, which can spew out more than half a ton of DU in one explosion, in anti-personnel bomblets, and even in M-16 and pistol shells.

The military loves DU for its unique penetration capability - it cuts through steel or concrete like they're butter.

"It doesn't seem right that we are poisoning the places we are supposed to be liberating," Ramos says. One way or another, the Pentagon will pay a price. "DU is a war crime. It's that simple," Rokke says. "Once you've scattered all this stuff around, and then refuse to clean it up, you've committed a war crime."

Moe'uhane, the Hawaiian word for dream, means "soul sleep." Hawaiians of old believed they communicated with 'aumakua, their ancestral guardians, while sleeping,



and this important relationship was sustained through dreaming. During "soul sleep" people received messages of guidance from the gods; romantic relationships blossomed; prophecies were made; cures were revealed. Dreams provided inspiration, conveying songs and dances that were remembered and performed upon waking. Specialists interpreted dreams, which were referred to an analyzed whenever important decisions were to be made. Having no written language, Hawaiians passed their history and life lessons down in the form of legends, which were committed to memory and told and retold. And within these stories are a multitude of dreams -- as in a famous legend of goddess Pele, who travels in a dream to meet and entrance the high chief Lohi'au. Dreams continue to play an important role in modern Hawaiian culture and are considered by some to have as powerful an influence today as in

ancient times. Artist Caren loebel-Fried retells and illuminates nine dream stories from Hawaii's past that are sure to please readers young and old, *kama'aina* and *malihini* alike. Loebel-Fried's bold, colorful block prints compliment the retelling of the legends of "The Hidden Spring of Punahou," "Kanaka-o-kai, the Man of the Sea," and others.

Like her earlier book, *Hawaiian Legends of the Guardian Spirits*, this newest book release by Caren Loebel-Fried will be appreciated by readers for her interpretations of legends and the unique block prints. The forward is by kihoalu master Keola Beamer who himself has recently released a CD entitled "Dreams of the Ponomoe."

Published by the University of Hawai'i Press [ISBN 0-8248-2961-1, pp.147, color illus, cloth]the book is available in book stores and libraries.

There has been widespread criticism of the response of US officials to Hurricane Katrina in New Orleans in 2005. The tone of these complaints is that the authorities failed to do their job quickly enough. But the truth is that government did not fail to respond in a timely fashion. The problem was that it did respond - but in such a way as to actually hinder rescue operations. There were too many instances for this to be merely a mistake or a bureaucratic snafu. Like the volunteer doctors who were told by FEMA guards to stop treating injured people. "We saw elderly patients who had been off their medicine for days, diabetics without insulin going into shock, uncontrolled hypertension, patients with psychosis and other mental disorders, lots of diarrhea, dehydration and things you would expect. FEMA showed up late and then rejected non-FEMA volunteer help for the sake of their organizational power and control.

They put form before function, and people died. FEMA issued a formal response to Dr. Perlmutter's story, acknowledging that the agency does not use voluntary physicians. "We have a cadre of physicians of our own," FEMA spokesman Kim Pease said Thursday. "They are the National Disaster Medical Team. ... The voluntary doctor was not a FEMA physician and, thus, was subject to law enforcement rules in a disaster area." A Coast Guard official informed Dr. Perlmutter and his assistant that he could not FEMA-credential them in the field or guarantee tort coverage and that they should return to Baton Rouge. "That shocked me, that those would be his concerns in a time of emergency," Gerhart said. After being forced back to back to Baton Rouge, Perlmutter's frustrated group went to state health officials who finally got them certified -- a simple process that took only a few seconds.

There is a clear pattern here that cannot be denied. Why ? Its about power, not saving lives. The primary job of the military, FEMA, and Homeland Security is to protect the government in times of emergency and keep it functioning. Their primary assignment is, not to rescue people, but to control them. Their directive is to relocate families , confiscate property, commandeer goods, direct labor and services, and establish martial law. The reason FEMA and Homeland security failed to carry out an effective rescue operation is that this was NOT their primary mission, and the reason they blocked others from doing so is that any operations not controlled by the central authority are contrary to their directives.

The FEMA objective was to bring the entire area under the control of the federal government - and this they succeeded in doing very well. They did not fail in New

Orleans. They were a huge success. Once this simple fact is understood, everything that happened in the wake of Katrina becomes understandable and logical.

And FEMA , BATF, HOMELAND SECURITY are soon coming to visit you, and you are supposed to believe it is JUST A TEST?

The last vestiges of the OLD REPUBLIC are being swept away by FEMA and Homeland Security and the unAmerican Patriot Acts passed by Congress without even reading them first. Now, "REGIONAL GOVERNORS will maintain their territories. FEAR WILL KEEP THE LOCAL SYSTEMS IN LINE!"
