Last weekend MPD police officers raided pakalolo patches in Hoolehua, and confiscated lots of weed, made at least one arrest of a resident on Hawaiian Homestead lands near the airport.

Also, a military helicopter and a yellow fire chopper were used by Green Harvest cops to survale the hills and valleys of Waialua Valley. It is unknown if any pakalolo was found in that effort, but a lot of people was the high flying cops dangling from cable suspended under the yellow copter, as shown in the photo taken by MAN reporter George Peabody.

This is dangerous work, and very expensive for Taxpayers, which begs the question: "Why do they continue to do it?"

The answer is GRANT MONEY from the federal Drug Enforcement Agency, and this police state behavior is ultra vires, i.e., anti-Constitutional. Hawaii County finally put a stop to it this year.....Wake UP Maui County: Stop it!



Sen Hutchison Supports Vote to support Gun Rights

September 17, 2008 Today, the U.S. House of Representatives opted to pass Representative Childers' D.C. gun ban repeal instead of the anti-gun bill sponsored by Del. Eleanor Holmes Norton -- which would have allowed D.C. to continue enacting gun control ultra vires.

The bill now goes to the Senate, but unless there is a ton of pressure put on Majority Leader Harry Reid, the bill will languish in committee.

Thankfully, Sen. Kay Bailey Hutchison is spearheading an effort to get a vote on the House-passed bill. She is asking her fellow Senators to cosponsor a letter which she will then deliver to Sen. Reid.

The Hutchison letter points out that, "In DC v. Heller, the court affirmed that the District of Columbia's ban on ownership of handguns was an unconstitutional restriction on that right."

After noting that D.C. has continued to deprive its residents of their Second Amendment rights for more than 30 years, the letter asks Sen. Reid "to ensure that D.C. residents do not have to wait any longer to realize their constitutional rights by allowing the full Senate to consider H.R. 6842 before the 110th Congress concludes."

There are not many days left before Congress recesses for the remainder of the year, and Sen. Reid is expected to try to run out the clock on the D.C. repeal bill. That's why it's important to act quickly and contact your own two U.S. Senators.

This is the last chance we have this year to put some teeth into the Supreme Court's decision in the Heller case ruling that the right to keep and bear arms is a right that cannot be infringed.

URGENT and MAKAAALA! DC Delegate Eleanor Holmes Norton (D) has managed to get an anti-gun bill onto the floor of the House. Her bill passed out of committee last week on a whopping 17-1 vote. Every Republican on the committee -- except for Rep. Dan Burton (R-IN) -- voted for the Norton bill along with all the democrats. The Norton bill would allow the DC council to continue enacting gun control, ban semi-auto pistols and rifles in DC, and registration requirements which require residents to get permission from the city council before they can own a firearm, and the lock-up your gun requirement.

H.S. Teacher Fights for Rights

A math teacher sued his school district after the principal Dawn Kastner told him the words "In God We Trust" and "All Men Are Created Equal, They Are Endowed By Their Creator" must be removed from his homeroom wall because they convey a Judeo-Christian viewpoint.

The Westview High School math teacher Bradley Johnson had the patriotic quote banners posted in his classroom for 25 years, and another that was posted for 17 years, now ordered to be taken down? even though 4,000 students have passed through Johnson's classroom without a single complaint.

The Thomas More Law Center, a not-for-profit law firm dedicated to the defense of religious freedoms, filed a federal lawsuit on behalf of Johnson against the Poway Unified School District of San Diego, Calif., which includes Westview High School, claiming the order to remove the banners violated Johnson's First Amendment freedom of speech, particularly since the district permits other teachers to hang Buddhist, Islamic, and Tibetan prayer messages in their classrooms.

Richard Thompson, president of the Law Center, commented, "Many public schools exhibit a knee-jerk hostility towards Christianity and seek to cleanse our nation's classrooms of our religious heritage while promoting atheism or other religions under the guise of cultural diversity."

The school district, in turn, filed to have the lawsuit dismissed. But last week, Federal District Judge Robert T. Benitez denied the request, stating, "Johnson has made out a clear claim for relief for an ongoing violation of his First Amendment free speech rights," and calling the principal's order "an unequivocal case of government hostility" toward the Judeo-Christian viewpoint.

"Judge Benitez's strongly worded opinion sends a clear message to school districts across the country that hostility toward our Nation's religious heritage is contrary to our Constitution," said Rober Muise, the Thomas More Law Center lawyer handling the case.

According to court documents, the school district argued for dismissal, saying that Johnson's banners do not enjoy First Amendment protections "because Johnson is speaking as an educator, not a citizen" and "because Johnson was a teacher, he had no First Amendment protections in his classroom."

Judge Benitez sharply disagreed, claiming the district's argument amounted to saying that Johnson has no free speech rights at all because he is a government employee.

Benitez quoted the 1969 Supreme Court decision Tinker v. Des Moines Independent Community School District, which stated, "It can hardly be argued that either students or teachers shed their constitutional rights to freedom of speech or expression at the school-house gate. This has been the unmistakable holding of this Court for almost 50 years."

The judge then added, "In the 40 years since, the Supreme Court has neither diminished the force of Tinker for teachers nor in any other way cabined the First Amendment speech of public school teachers."

Benitez then presented a strong rebuttal to the charge that the Declaration of Independence and phrases like "In God We Trust" represent unconstitutional religious establishment. "The Court does not understand Johnson's banners as communicating a religious Judeo-Christian viewpoint," Benitez wrote in his decision. "Rather, the banners communicated fundamental political messages and celebrate important American shared historical experiences....That God places prominently in our nation's history does not create an Establishment Clause problem requiring curettage and disinfectant of Johnson's classroom walls. It is a matter of historical fact that our institutions and government actors have in past and present times given place to a supreme God."

Benitez then quoted a 1952 Supreme Court ruling, Zorach v. Clauson: "We are a religious people whose institutions presuppose a Supreme Being." By squelching only Johnson's patriotic expression, the school district does a disservice to the students of Westview High School, and the federal and state constitutions do not permit such one-sided censorship."
