## Cooking Catches on With Molokai residents: There's more to it than daily bread



It looks like the Molokai Culinary Center has hit a nerve. Whether it's the high cost of food, sentimental memories of family recipes, or simply an idea whose time has come, the idea of cooking lessons is taking off. Don Hill, the chef instructor at the Center reports that during July, August and September, there will have been at least 18 people who have attended six lessons/workshops and practiced a total of 21 different recipes. A few brave souls have attended as many as three sessions each. The most productive session was on Friday, Sept 16, when four participants created 224 servings of pastry for the St.

Damien Country Fair in only three hours! The most economical session was the tortilla class coordinated by Brianne Childs, where participants made 10 flour tortillas with 60 cents worth of flour. Hill made a tortilla press before the class and Childs reports that she will never buy another tortilla.

While the initial demand has been for baking classes, Hill wants the community to know that he is prepared to teach any of about 56 different lessons, including soups, salads, pupus, main dishes, and desserts. He has several software programs he can demonstrate, and a virtually unlimited source of recipes, from the internet and his chef friends on Facebook.

Another suggestion which will be put into action is a "couples night" where one or more couples book an evening lesson ending with a three course meal served on the lanai. Hill envisions two versions. The first has the couple working together; and the second has one person arriving two hours before the "dinner guest". He plans to run the first couples evening before the end of September.

The Molokai Culinary Center continues to look for a commercial kitchen. There is NO CHARGE for cooking lessons, but donations toward food costs or donated food such as venison, produce or fish is appreciated, and probably would result in an invitation to dinner. ### California cop pleads not guilty in homeless man's death?

Demonstrators held created a makeshift memorial for Kelly Thomas, a homeless man who died as several police officers beat him. Police received a call about a homeless man looking in car windows and pulling on handles of parked cars. None of the cars had been opened, nothing stolen, and Kelly had no drugs.

Only two of the six officers are charged with involuntary manslaughter and felony use of excessive force after they systematically for almost 10-minutes beat to death 24-year old Kelly Thomas as he pleaded for his life. Citizens called police to stop the beating, and video taped the crime, but fear retaliation by police and charges of interfering with "government operations".

Six officers were put on paid leave after Kelly Thomas died in July.

Officer Jay Patrick Cicinelli was released Wednesday on \$25,000 bail, according to his attorney and a spokeswoman for the prosecutor.

Arraignment of officer Manuel Anthony Ramos was being held Wednesday after Orange County Superior Court Judge Erick L. Larsh set his bail at \$1 million.

Ramos, who is 37 and a 10-year veteran of Fullerton police, is charged with 2nddegree murder and manslaughter in the beating death of Kelly Thomas.

The judge ordered both officers to surrender their guns within 24 hours.

The actions of Ramos "were reckless and created a high risk of death and great bodily injury," District Attorney Tony Rackauckas told reporters. It's a person saying he's sorry, calling for his dad and asking for help. It's heartbreaking. It's hard to listen," Rackauckas said of the video.

Ramos faces a maximum sentence of 15 years to life if convicted, authorities said. Cicinelli, who is 39 years old and a 12-year veteran of Fullerton police, faces a maximum of four years in prison if convicted for "acting recklessly, under the color of authority without lawful necessity," the prosecutor's office said. Ramos made "a deliberate showing of putting on Latex gloves, and making two fists in front of Thomas in his detention of Thomas. Ramos lifted his fists to Kelly Thomas and said, You see my fists? Now they're getting to ready to fuck you up.

"Ramos had to know that he was creating a situation where Kelly Thomas feared for his life and was struggling to get away from an armed officer who was going to 'F' him up," prosecutor Rackauckas said. Also, multiple taser shocks.

The FBI is also investigating civil rights violations in the case.

Cicinelli, who arrived at the scene later, is accused of using excessive force when he allegedly assaulted and beat Thomas using the front end of his Taser to hit Thomas in the head and face eight times while Thomas was pinned to the ground by other officers and was making no audible sounds, indicating that Thomas was "down and seriously injured," the prosecutor's office said.

Rackauckas said Ramos' conduct was "not protecting and serving" the public.

Asked about the charged officers' motive, the prosecutor responded: That's a pretty good question. It just appears to be escalation. 'I can't breathe,' 'I'm sorry, dude,' 'Please,' 'OK, OK,' 'Dad, help me, defense motivated by pain and fear.

In Salpula, Oklahoma, the Valley Brook police chief was arraigned on September 14 on drug trafficking and possession charges. Chief Melvin Fisher Jr., 47, had been arrested on Labor Day after being pulled over in a "routine traffic stop" by the Oklahoma State Patrol. He is accused of possessing 20 grams of methamphetamine, an unknown quantity of marijuana, and drug paraphernalia. He is charged with drug trafficking, two charges of unlawful possession of a controlled drug with intent to distribute and one charge of unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia. The chief is out on \$31,000 bail and has asked for a temporary leave of absence. He is set for a preliminary hearing on October 5.

In Albuquerque, a former Albuquerque police officer was sentenced Tuesday to six months and a day in jail and six months on supervised release after being convicted of tipping off a friend who was the target of an ongoing federal narcotics and stolen merchandise investigation. Brad Ahrenfield, 46, leaked details of an FBI scheme to bust one of his friend's employees for small-time drug dealing, then get the employee to flip on the friend, forcing end to investigation.

Beginning a Running Program

Whether you're thinking about your first marathon, 5k race or just want a little extra exercise, beginning a running program is a rewarding endeavor, albeit quite daunting.

So before you lace up and head out on the trail, here's a few tips.

First, you need to decide what kind of program you're thinking about starting. If you're just looking to get in shape or battle some stress, a light jogging program is perfect. In this case, your running progression will depend on your current level of fitness. If you've been inactive for a long period of time, begin by walking. Progress your training to a walk/run combination before finally moving on to a full session of jogging.

By doing this, you'll ease your muscles, joints and lungs back into fitness shape and avoid injury.

If you're looking to hit a short to midsize race, like a 5k or 10k, you need to structure your program more specific to your event needs. Again, you need to start slow, but you need to back time your progression to your targeted race date. It's dangerous to pick a competition too close to the start of your training. If you decide today to start training for a race that's week away, you're setting yourself up for serious injury or failure. For the sake of your body and your personal finishing time, give yourself a couple months to work into proper shape.

For those ambitious few that want to go from zero to marathon, it takes a lot more planning. Please don't think you can step onto the starting line with little or no training. That is an extremely dangerous move and will likely land you in the medical tent.

For those who don't know, a marathon is 26.2 miles of running, up and down hills, usually on public roads, rain or shine. If you're serious, begin moving a year prior to your race. Most marathon running programs backdate your training about six months before your race. These programs are widely found online or in running stores, but usually expect participants to already be moderate running shape before beginning.

On the surface, it seems like there's a lot to figure out before you first get on the treadmill, but a little planning can go a long way in preventing injury and enhancing your running experience.

For this week's easy fit mini recipe, I'm going to suggest something a little different. Instead of a true recipe, I'm going to give my favorite carbohydrate loading meal. First I take whole wheat spaghetti pasta and add plain sauce. I like to keep my sauce bland so that I can add my own spices; parsley, oregano, thyme, paprika, salt and pepper are what I throw in my sauce. Finally, I add turkey meat meatballs and enjoy. I eat this meal a day prior to any big race, thus ensuring a proper energy balance for my race.

# Obama-skies Taxed: No Aloha

IMPORTANT! Flying with Obama-Taxation is MORE EXPENSIVE!

Barack Obama has repeatedly denounced "tax breaks" for corporate jets in recent speeches, fliers of almost all stripes will feel a pinch under the budget plan he announced Monday.

Travelers who fly anything from jumbo jets to puddle jumpers, private or commercial, first class or coach, would all see increased taxes or fees under the plan. The only groups exempt from new or increased fees would be pilots of recreational piston aircraft, military aircraft, air ambulances and public aircraft such as police helicopters.

As in the past, the aviation community responded as one to the proposal, delivering an immediate jet blast of criticism, saying the fees would hurt the aviation industry, kill jobs and harm the economy.

The administration proposal called for the following fee increases:

-- Aviation Passenger Security Fee: The president wants to bump the Aviation Passenger Security Fee, a post-9/11 fee intended to pay for the cost of security. Currently, passengers pay \$2.50 for each leg of a trip, with a maximum of \$5 for a one-way trip. Under the proposal, the "per-leg" costs would be replaced with a standard \$5 per trip fee, with annual increases of 50 cents from 2013 to 2017, resulting in a fee of \$7.50 in 2017 and thereafter.

The administration says the current fees cover only 43% of the Transportation Security Administration's security costs. The proposed fee would collect an additional \$8.8 billion over five years, and \$24.9 billion over 10 years -- with \$15 billion being directed to the general fund to reduce the deficit.

-- Corporate jet tax: The president wants to impose a \$100 per flight fee for all aircraft that fly in controlled airspace. He says the fee will make the system more fair and generate an estimated \$11 billion over 10 years.

Currently, the administration says, commercial airlines pay the lion's share of air traffic control services through ticket taxes, segment fees, international taxes and fuel fees. Corporate jets pay a fuel tax, but that does not represent a fair share of the expense, the administration said.

"A large commercial aircraft would pay between \$1,300 to \$2,000 in taxes for a flight from Los Angeles to San Francisco while a corporate jet flying the same route and using the same Federal Aviation Administration air traffic services would pay about \$60 in taxes," the administration said. The \$100 per flight fee would help reduce the deficit and more equitably share the cost of air traffic control expenses, it said.

The total charges would fund roughly three-fourths of air traffic control costs and airport improvements.

"We oppose any new taxes on airlines or their passengers," said Nicholas Calio, president of the Air Transport Association of America, the trade group for the largest U.S. airlines. "We already pay more than our fair share of taxes -- more than the alcohol and tobacco industries, whose products are taxed at levels to discourage their use."

In 2010, the airline industry and passengers paid \$3.4 billion in taxes and fees, while industry profits were under \$4 billion, he said.

A consortium of other airliner groups also blasted the proposal.

The Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association noted that the industry had supported per-gallon fuel tax increases in the past. It said the \$100 per flight tax proposal would create a new administrative burden on general aviation operators and result in a "costly new federal collection bureaucracy."

Previous efforts to increase the passenger security fee and to impose a "segment fee" on aircraft flights have died in Congress.




